Dear Families:

I would like to begin this message of the second Sunday of Easter with words from the First Letter of St. Peter 2:2: "...and, like newborn infants, long for pure spiritual milk so that, through it you may grow into salvation..."

What is St. Peter trying to tell us here? The child needs good, nourishing food to help him grow healthy and strong. We are, through Baptism, those newborn children - born in Christ's Easter - who must seek in our Mother, the Church, pure spiritual food. It is important to look at the real sources, otherwise we will be given (or sold) adulterated food. St. Peter is warning the first Christians not to be deceived by false prophets, evangelists or preachers who claim to offer spiritual food in appearance, but in reality it is contaminated with their own doctrines and interpretations of the faith in Christ - different from the truth transmitted by the firsthand witnesses, the apostles. Today, these apostles are our Bishops, who, without interruption, have been in the line of succession from those first apostles, ever since the beginning of the preaching of the Gospel. This unadulterated spiritual milk is the sound doctrine, conveyed to us by the Church, through this succession of Bishops. Priests, everywhere, continue to preach in obedience and fidelity to the doctrine emanating from the Bishops, the true and authentic successors of the apostles.

This is the truth "that leads to salvation". Other voices, opinions, or bickering are, at best, but half-truths, and, at worst, fallacies. No one can say that their faith is inherited from the apostles, if they are not in communion with the Bishops and the Pope, the visible head of Christ's Church on earth.

Dear families, I tell you all this firmly because it saddens me to observe how many people, young couples, teenagers, even mature people - are misled by those who appear in the media, preaching about eternal punishment and the end of the world, while attacking the Catholic Church. You are very important and do not deserve prophets of doom and despair. You deserve the announcement of the love of our saving God, in Christ Jesus. God loves you with an everlasting love. As a mother, God wants to nourish us in His Church, with the pure and spiritual milk of **TRUTH**.

Have faith and live in hope. Do not be like doubting Thomas, the Apostle, but rather be strong men and women, standing solid in your faith and confident in your ability to access the personal experience of God's merciful love, while enthusiastically encouraging those around you to do the same.

Today, Christ is with you and He says to you: **PEACE** be with you. Blessed are you who believe in the Lord.

Queridas Familias:

Quiero comenzar este mensaje del segundo domingo de Pascua con unas palabras de la Primera Carta de San Pedro 2,2: "Y, como niños recién nacidos, busquen ansiosamente la leche espiritual no adulterada que les permitirá crecer hasta que alcancen la salvación".

¿De qué nos habla aquí San Pedro?: El niño necesita el alimento bueno y sano que le ayude a estar en buena salud y un crecimiento fuerte. Nosotros somos, por el Bautismo, esos niños recién nacidos en la Pascua de Cristo que debemos buscar en nuestra Madre, la Iglesia, el alimento puro y espiritual sin adulteraciones. Es importante buscar en las verdaderas fuentes, pues de lo contrario nos darán o nos venderán un alimento adulterado. San Pedro está advirtiendo a los primeros cristianos que no se dejen engañar por falsos profetas o evangelistas o predicadores que pretenden ofrecer un alimento en apariencia espiritual, pero contaminado con propias doctrinas e interpretaciones de la fe en Cristo distinta a aquellas que los testigos de primera mano, los apóstoles, nos transmiten. Hoy esos apóstoles son nuestros Obispos, que vienen sucediendo a aquellos primeros apóstoles sin interrupción desde los tiempos del comienzo de la predicación del evangelio. Esta leche espiritual, no adulterada, es la sana doctrina que nos transmite la Iglesia a través de los Obispos. El sacerdote en cada lugar no hace más que predicar en obediencia y en fidelidad a la doctrina que emana de los Obispos, verdaderos y auténticos sucesores de los apóstoles.

Esta es la verdad "que conduce a la salvación"; otras voces, opiniones, dimes o diretes no son más que verdades a medias o falsas verdades. Nadie puede decir que su fe es herencia de los apóstoles si no está en comunión con los Obispos y con el Papa, cabeza visible de Cristo en la tierra.

Queridas familias: Todo esto se lo digo con firmeza pues me da tristeza constatar cómo mucha gente-parejas jóvenes, adolescentes, incluso gente madura - se deja llevar por los primeros charlatanes que aparecen en televisión o vociferando por los radio castigos eternos, o fin del mundo o atacando a la Iglesia Católica. Ustedes son muy importantes y no merecen profetas de calamidades y desesperanzas; ustedes merecen el anuncio del amor de Dios salvador en Cristo Jesús. Dios les ama con amor eterno. Como una madre, Dios quiere alimentarnos en su Iglesia con la leche pura y espiritual de la **VERDAD**.

Tengan fe y no duden nunca. No sean indecisos como el apóstol Tomás, sino hombres y mujeres firmes, capaces de transmitir con entusiasmo la alegría de su fe y la experiencia personal del amor misericordioso de Dios.

Cristo hoy está a tu lado y te dice: La **PAZ** contigo. Dichoso tú si crees así en el Señor.

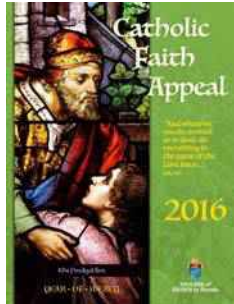

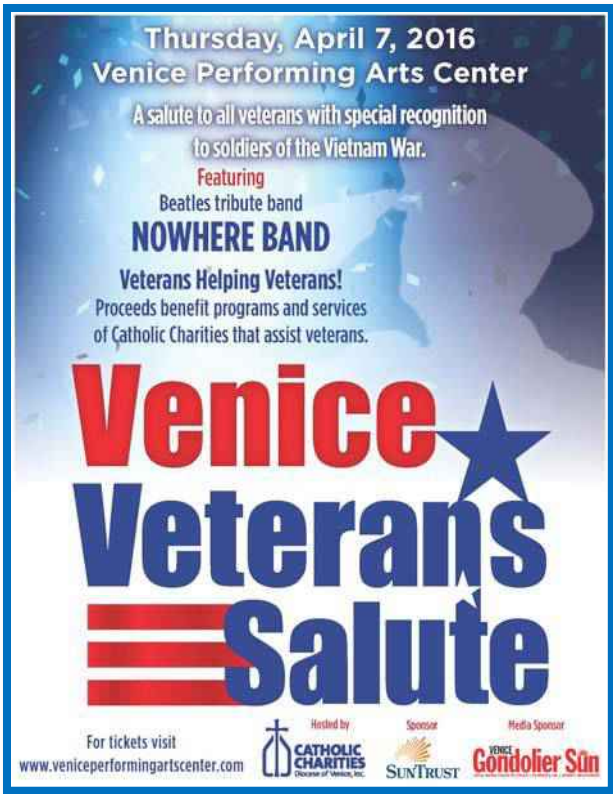
