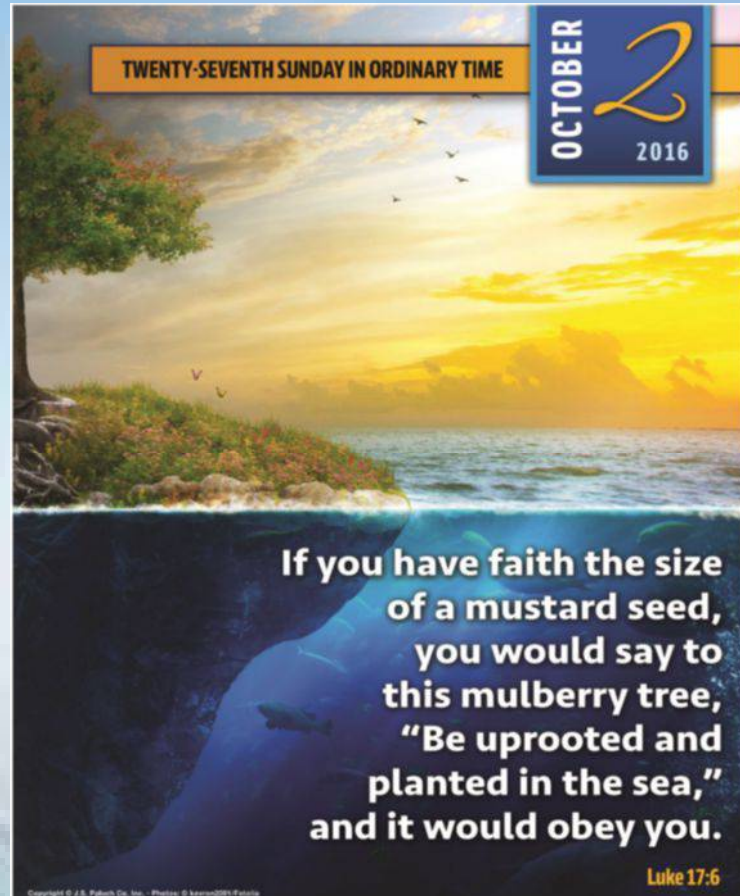

Twenty-Seventh Sunday in Ordinary Time

Dear Families:

More than a Sunday message, I would like to write today about an important feast this month. On October 7th, the Church celebrates the feast of **Our Lady of the Rosary**.

This feast stems from the Feast of St. Mary of Victory, instituted by Pope St. Pius V after the victory in Lepanto (Greece) by the Christian armies, against the Turks (who attacked Christianity) on Sunday, October 7, 1571. History tells us that, although the Christian forces were inferior to the Turks, they were confident in their ultimate victory, because of their faith in the Blessed Virgin Mary to whom they constantly prayed the Rosary.

In many parts of Christendom entire villages were in permanent prayer of the Rosary to the Blessed Virgin Mary. Upon the death of Pope St. Pius V, his successor Gregory XIII made mandatory the celebration of this feast for the Diocese of Rome and for the Confraternities of the Holy Rosary in 1573, under the title of Most Holy Rosary of Our Lady the Virgin Mary. In 1716 Pope Clement XI established this feast for the entire Church in thanksgiving for the victory (in 1683, after the liberation of Vienna) obtained by Prince Eugene against the Turks in Peterwardein (Austria), with the liberation of Cyprus. Since 1960, the title of this feast is known as **Our Lady of the Rosary**.

Now, what is the Rosary? The crown of the Rosary as a series of strung beads to count prayers, seems very old. The anchorites (people dedicated to live in solitude, contemplation and penance), used pebbles to count their vocal prayers. But the use of repeating the Hail Mary dates back to the twelfth century. Towards 1328, a "Rosarius" (or collection of miracles of Our Lady) attributed to St. Domingo the salvation of the world through his preaching of "**HAIL MARYS**" that would be repeated, meditated or sung. But the great propagator of the Rosary was Father Dominic B. Alano de la Roche, in 1745.

This is how this feast of Our Lady of the Rosary and the devotion to the Holy Rosary has come to our days. The good that it has done and continues to do for humanity is immeasurable, but will this ever end? Here's a message for our consideration: Let us truly put to practice this devotion of the Rosary, and pass it on to our loved ones, children, family and friends. In a world that is so materialistic, there is a need for Christians to demonstrate that spirituality is the foundation of all human life on earth, and that without the spirituality of love for God and the Virgin Mary, we fall into paganism and in a great degradation of the dignity of the person.

Let us pray for peace, for an end to terrorism. Let us pray for the protection of life, of all human life.

THANK YOU to our group "Our Lady's Rosary Makers". They make the Rosaries for the catechism children, for prisons, for missions in other countries and for the many families in our parish. Let us give them our support. Thank you!

May God and the Virgin Mary bless you. Pray the Rosary, this is the month specially dedicated to this devotion.

Vigésimo Séptimo Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

2 de Octubre del 2016

Haba 1:2-3, 2:2-4; 2 Tim 1:6-8, 13-14; Lucas 17:5-10
Salmo 95 [94]

Queridas Familias:

Más que un mensaje del domingo quisiera escribirles hoy acerca de una fiesta importante de este mes. El 7 de octubre, celebra la Iglesia la fiesta de **Nuestra Señora la Virgen del Rosario**.

Esta fiesta deriva de la fiesta de Santa María de la Victoria, instituida por el Papa San Pío V tras la victoria obtenida por los ejércitos cristianos contra los turcos (que atacaban la cristiandad) el domingo, 7 de octubre de 1571, en Lepanto (Grecia). Cuenta la historia que los ejércitos cristianos embarcados eran inferiores a los turcos, pero que en el ánimo de los soldados estaba la seguridad de la victoria gracias a su fe en la Santísima Virgen a la que rezaban sin cesar el Rosario. En muchas partes de la cristiandad pueblos enteros estaban en oración permanente rezando el Rosario a la Santísima Virgen. A la muerte del Papa San Pío V, su sucesor Gregorio XIII hizo obligatoria la celebración de esta fiesta para la Diócesis de Roma y para las Confraternidades del Santo Rosario en el año 1573, bajo el título de Santísimo Rosario de Nuestra Señora la Virgen María. En 1716 el Papa Clemente XI establecía esta fiesta para toda la Iglesia en agradecimiento a la victoria (en 1683, tras la liberación de Viena) obtenida por el príncipe Eugenio contra los turcos en Peterwardein (Austria), con la liberación de Chipre. Y desde el año 1960 el título de esta fiesta es como la conocemos **Nuestra Señora del Rosario**.

Ahora bien, ¿qué es el Rosario? La corona del rosario, como serie de cuentas engarzadas para contar las oraciones, parece muy antigua; los anacoretas (personas entregadas en solitario a la contemplación y la penitencia) usaban piedritas para contar sus oraciones vocales. Pero el uso de repetir el avemaría se remonta al siglo XII. Hacia 1328, un "Rosarios" (o recopilación de milagros de Nuestra Señora) atribuida a Santo Domingo de Guzmán la salvación del mundo gracias a su predicación de las "**AVE MARIAS**", meditadas o repetidas o contadas. Pero fue el Padre Dominic B. Alano de la Roche, en 1745, el gran propagador del Rosario.

Así ha llegado hasta nuestros días esta fiesta de Nuestra Señora la Virgen del Rosario y esta devoción del rezo del Santo Rosario. El bien que esto ha hecho y sigue haciendo a la humanidad es incalculable, pero ¿se terminará algún día?...He aquí un mensaje para nuestra consideración: Ponernos de verdad a practicar esta devoción del Rosario y transmitirla a los nuestros, a nuestros hijos, familiares y amistades. En un mundo tan materializado hacen falta cristianos que muestren con hechos que lo espiritual es el fundamento de toda vida humana sobre la tierra y que sin esa espiritualidad de amor a Dios y a la Virgen caemos en un paganismo y en una gran degradación de la dignidad de la persona.

Recemos por la paz, para que cese el terrorismo. Recemos por la defensa de la vida, de toda vida humana.

GRACIAS a nuestro Grupo "Rosary Makers". Ellos fabrican los Rosarios para los niños de la catequesis, para las cárceles, para lugares de misión en Perú Guatemala y también para familias de nuestra parroquia. Colaboren con ellos. ¡Gracias!

Que Dios y la Virgen los bendiga. Recen el Rosario, este es el mes dedicado de forma especial a esta devoción.

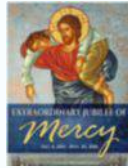

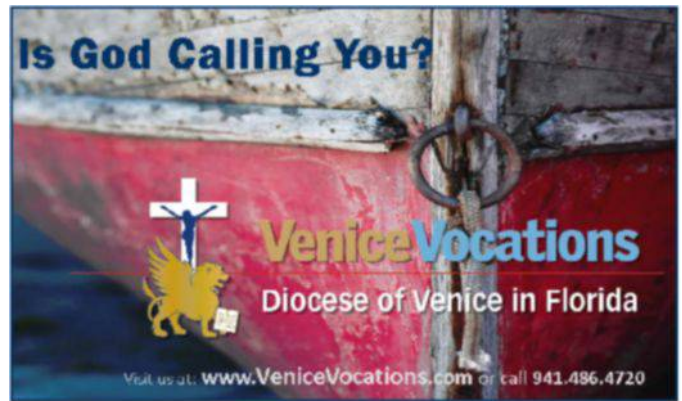
