Easter Sunday The Resurrection of the Lord

April 16, 2017

Acts 10:34-37-43; Col. 3:1-4; John 20:1-9
Psalm 118

Dear Families:

EASTER. Today is a day of Great News. Gospel etymologically means, "good news." The message of Christ was extraordinary news for his contemporaries, both Jews and Gentiles.

For us today - from childhood accustomed to hearing the amazing news about Christ - there is a danger that the sensational event loses not only its novelty, but also the strength thereby required to excite a conscious and reflective interest.

From time to time we need to awaken our dormant sense of wonder, in order to grasp the Gospel message in its original tone of **Great News**.

For years, we are eagerly awaiting the announcement - only God knows what headlines will appear in the media - that medical science has finally discovered an infallible cure for cancer and AIDS. But we would never expect any news claiming that man has once and for all managed to defeat death because we are convinced that nothing like that will ever happen.

And yet, this story, The Great News - occurred nearly two thousand years ago, and reached everyone who believed in Christ.

The angels announced it for the first time on a day like today to the pious women who were amazed at the empty tomb in Jerusalem: **Why do you seek the living among the dead? He is not here, but he has been raised.**

Gravestones usually read: "Here lies." Christ's should say: **"He is not here. He has risen"**.

No wonder, when Festus, Roman procurator at Caesarea, was explaining to King Agrippa the case of the Apostle Paul, whom he had prisoner, he said that the Jews were against him on account of a certain Jesus, who had died, but who Paul claimed was alive (Acts 25:19).

Domingo de Pascua La Resurrección del Señor

Queridas Familias:

PASCUA. Hoy es el día de la Gran Noticia. Evangelio significa etimológicamente "buen anuncio", "noticia buena". Y el mensaje de Cristo fue noticia extraordinaria para sus contemporáneos, tanto judíos como gentiles.

Para nosotros hoy acostumbrados desde niños a oír las sorprendentes noticias sobre Cristo existe el peligro de que el sensacional acontecimiento pierda su gran novedad y con ello la fuerza necesaria para excitar un interés consciente y reflexivo.

Necesitamos despertar de cuando en cuando nuestra dormida capacidad de asombro, para captar el mensaje evangélico en su tono original de **Gran Noticia**.

Hace años estamos esperando impacientes el anuncio sólo Dios sabe con qué titulares aparecerán en los medios de comunicación de que la ciencia médica ha descubierto por fin un remedio infalible contra las plagas del cáncer y del sida. Pero no se nos ocurre esperar porque tenemos la certeza de que no ha de producirse nunca la noticia de que el hombre consiga evitar definitivamente la muerte.

Y, sin embargo, esta noticia, La Gran Noticia se produjo hace casi dos mil años, y llegó a conocimiento de los que creen en Cristo.

Los ángeles lo anunciaron por primera vez, tal día como hoy, a las piadosas mujeres asombradas ante la tumba vacía de Cristo en Jerusalén. **Por qué buscan entre los muertos al que vive?** No está aquí, ha resucitado.

Sobre las lapidas de los sepulcros suele haber un letrero que dice "Aquí yace". Sobre el de Cristo hay que poner: **"No está aquí. Ha resucitado"**.

No es extraño que, cuando Festo, procurador romano en Cesarea, le explicaba al rey Agripa el caso del Apóstol Pablo, a quien tenía prisionero, dijera que los judíos estaban contra él a cuenta de un tal Jesús, ya muerto, del que Pablo asegura que está vivo (Hch 25,19).

Jesus has defeated death and with this he inaugurates the act of dying to resurrect. He has risen forever: **"We know that Christ, raised from the dead, dies no more; death no longer has power over him"** (Rom 6:9). We rejoice in the triumph of Christ and congratulate him on it. On a day like today, Eastern Christians do not greet each other with the usual good morning, but rather say: "Christ is risen". And the other replies, "Hallelujah!" The Emmaus groups raise their voices saying: "Christ has risen; He has truly risen!"

Those of us who believe in Christ can rejoice and congratulate ourselves today for our participation in Christ's victory over death. Jesus said: **"I am the Resurrection and the Life; whoever believes in me, even if he dies, will live; and everyone who lives and believes in me will never die"** (Jn. 11:25-26).
