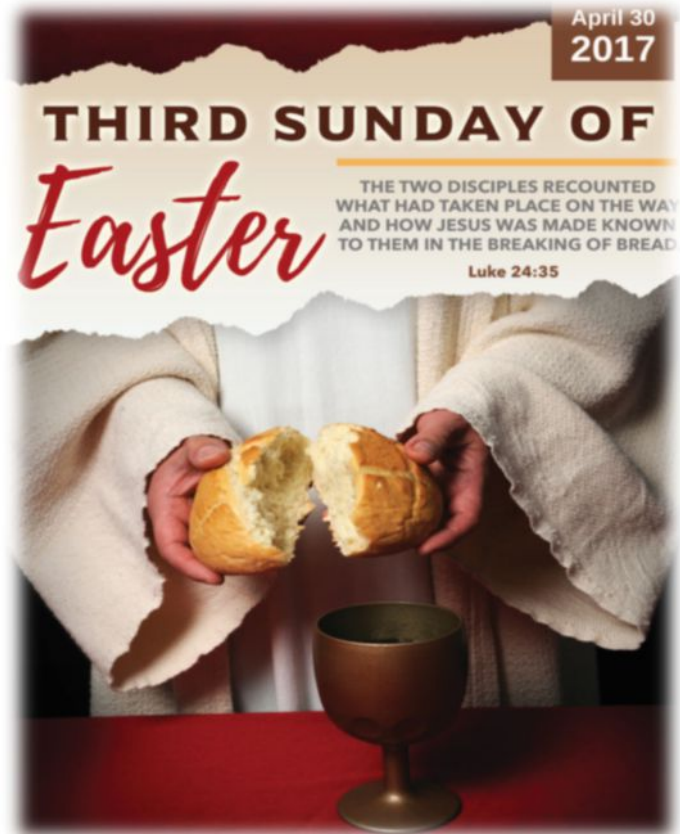

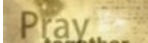

Acts 2:14, 22-33; 1 Peter 1:17-21; Luke 24:13-35
Psalm 16

Dear Families:

Today's Gospel describes the appearance (apparition) of Jesus to the disciples of Emmaus. This is a beautiful story that contains many teachings.

The risen Jesus approached the two disciples who were returning from Jerusalem to their village and started a conversation with them. Their eyes were prevented from recognizing him, and they did not want to engage in conversation. Jesus broke the silence and asked them why they were looking downcast. They replied to him with another question: "Are you the only visitor to Jerusalem who does not know of the things that have taken place there in these days?" "What sort of things?" Jesus asked in reply. The disciples of Emmaus elaborately explained what happened and how they, who were hoping that he would be the triumphant redeemer, have been disappointed. Suddenly the traveler interrupted them, calling them foolish and slow of heart, to believe all that the prophets spoke about the suffering Messiah, prior to entering into his glory.

(Prayer: Help us, Lord to convince ourselves that, on Good Friday, all the blessings flow from God to man through the cross, and that, only if we experience it, we can cross from the region of the shadows, into the light of the world. Amen).

On the way, Jesus spoke with them, interpreting those Scriptural passages which referred to him. Later, the Emmaus disciples would talk of their hearts burning within them while he spoke to them on the way and opened the Scriptures to them.

As they approached the village to which they were going, he gave the impression that he was going on farther. But they urged him, "Stay with us, for it is nearly evening and the day is almost over." In reality they felt comfortable and protected with the stranger because they were afraid of what happened in Jerusalem.

That night in Emmaus, he went in to stay with them. And it happened that, while he was with them at table, "He took bread, said the blessing, broke it, and gave it to them. With that their eyes were opened and they recognized him, and with that, he vanished from their sight."

So with this, Jesus clearly told us that he is with us in the "Breaking of bread" (the Eucharist "the Holy Mass). Even when we do not see him.

(Prayer: "Lord, if those from Emmaus knew you and we know you "in the breaking of the bread, the Eucharist, then we only need you to know us when we break bread with our brothers and sisters. Amen).

Tercer Domingo de Pascua

30 de Abril del 2017

Hechos 2:14, 22-33; 1 Pedro 1:17-21; Lucas 24:13-35
Salmo 16 [15]

Queridas Familias:

La aparición de Jesús a los discípulos de Emaus que nos refiere la tercera lectura de este domingo es un bello relato que contiene multitud de enseñanzas.

Jesús resucitado alcanza a los dos discípulos que regresaban de Jerusalén a su pueblo, y pretende trabar conversación con ellos; pero sus ojos no eran capaces de reconocerlo. Da la impresión que no quieren entablar conversación con él; pero Jesús rompe el silencio y les pregunta por que van cabizbajos y apenados. Ellos le responden con otra pregunta: "Eres tu el único forastero que no conoce los sucesos de estos días en Jerusalén?" "¿Cuáles?" pregunta el a su vez. Los de Emaus se explayaron refiriendo lo ocurrido y como ellos, que esperaban su triunfo, se han visto defraudados. De pronto el viajero los interrumpe llamándolos necios y torpes para creer lo que anunciaron los profetas sobre los padecimientos del Mesías, previamente a la entrada en su Reino.

(Oración: Ayúdanos, Señor a convencernos de que, a partir del Viernes Santo, todas las bendiciones pasan de la orilla de Dios a la orilla del hombre en forma de cruz, y de que solo colgados a ella podremos pasar nosotros de la región de las sombras al país de la luz. Amen).

En el camino, Jesús fue explicando todo lo que se refería a él en las Sagradas Escrituras. Luego dirigió a los de Emaus que ardían sus corazones dentro de ellos, cuando les hablaba y les declaraba las Escrituras.

Cuando llegaron a donde iban, el fingió seguir adelante; pero ellos le apremian diciendo: "¿Quédate con nosotros, porque atardece y el día va de cada." En realidad se sentían a gusto con el desconocido y en el fondo protegidos, pues tenían miedo por lo sucedido en Jerusalén.

Aquella noche en Emaus entró con ellos a la casa y se sentó a la mesa, tomó el pan, pronunció la bendición, lo partió y se lo dio. A ellos se les abrieron los ojos y lo reconocieron. Pero él desapareció.

Así Jesús nos dijo claramente que está con nosotros en la "Fracción del pan" (La Eucaristía "La Santa Misa). Aunque no lo veamos.

(Oración: "Señor, si los de Emaus te conocieron y nosotros te conocemos "al partir el pan de la Eucaristía, solo falta que todos conozcamos al partir el pan nosotros con los hermanos. Amén).

Que Dios los bendiga.
