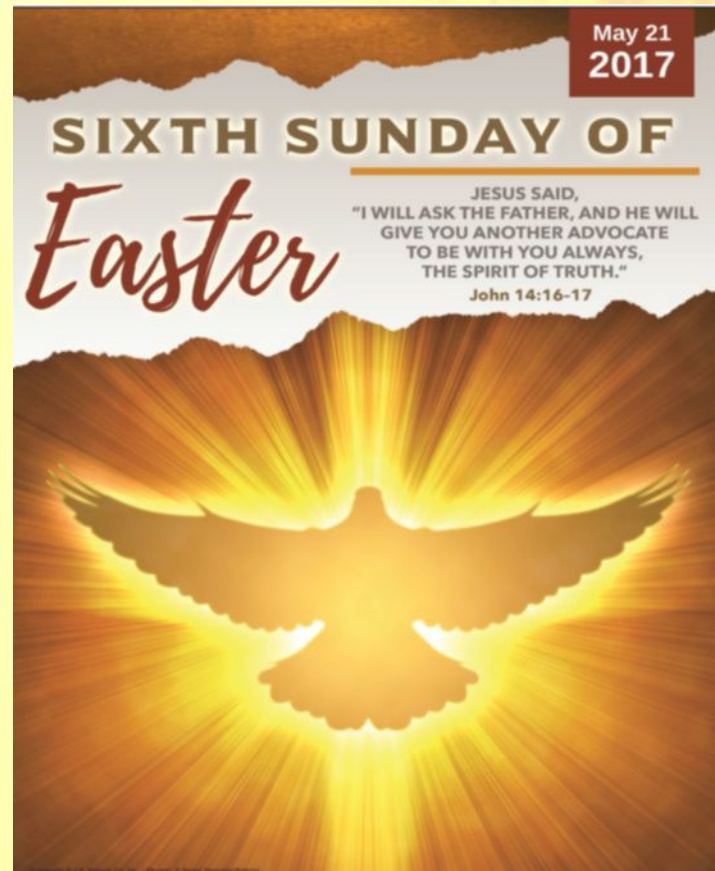

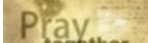

## Sixth Sunday of Easter

May 21, 2017

Acts 8:5-8, 14-17; 1Peter 3:15-18; John 14:15-21  
Psalm 66

Dear Families:

Within two weeks we celebrate the feast of Pentecost, which is why today's readings invite us to reflect on aspects of the role of the Holy Spirit in the Christian community. Easter and Pentecost are complementary aspects of the same mystery: the risen Jesus, who lives by the breath of the Spirit and shares it with the Christian community; the risen Jesus who makes himself present in the midst of the apostles, grants them his peace, and then breathes on them, saying, **"Receive the Holy Spirit"** (Jn 20:23).

If Easter is the birth of the community, it is the Holy Spirit who gives it fullness and maturity. The Spirit of the Risen Christ is what guides, directs and develops the community; a spirit of strength, truth, unity and love.

Easter and Pentecost lead us to several discoveries. Through Baptism, Christians are united to the crucified and risen Christ. Then, through the Sacrament of Confirmation, they are united with the entire community as mature members - a consequence of the presence of the Holy Spirit in them. **Receiving the Holy Spirit is more than receiving the sacrament of Confirmation, in the same way that being a Christian is much more than just being baptized.** It's important to understand that, through the Holy Spirit, we are able to "internalize" our faith so that it becomes more than a set of exterior rules and rituals. **Receiving the Spirit of Christ is to live our faith, according to the Gospel, in a way that cannot be completely defined by any book, ritual or code.**

Let us pray this week, prior to the Sunday of the Ascension of the Lord and the week preceding Pentecost, that the Spirit may become deeply present within us, allowing our faith to grow and adapt to new circumstances, driven by the great principle of Love.

May the peace of Christ and His Spirit be ever present in your families.

## Sexto Domingo de Pascua

21 de Mayo del 2017

Hechos 8:5-8, 14-17; 1 Pedro 3:15-18; Juan 14:15-21  
Salmo 66 [65]

Queridas Familias:

Dentro de dos semanas celebramos la fiesta de Pentecostá, de ahí que las lecturas de hoy nos invitan a reflexionar sobre algunos aspectos del papel que cumple el Espíritu Santo en la comunidad cristiana. Pascua y Pentecostá son dos complementos del mismo misterio: Jesús resucitado, que vive con el soplo del Espíritu, lo recibe para darlo a la comunidad. Jesús resucitado que se hace presente en medio de los apóstoles, les da su paz y después sopla sobre ellos diciendo: **"Recibid el Espíritu Santo"** (Jn 20:23).

Si la Pascua es el nacimiento de la comunidad, es el Espíritu Santo quien le confiere plenitud y madurez. Quien guía, orienta y desarrolla a la es el Espíritu de Cristo resucitado: espíritu de fuerza de verdad, de unión y de amor.

Pascua y Pentecostá nos hacen descubrir lo siguiente: los cristianos reciben el Bautismo, por el que se unen a Cristo muerto y resucitado; después reciben la Confirmación, que es la unión total a la comunidad como miembros maduros debido a la presencia en ellos del Espíritu Santo. **Recibir el Espíritu Santo es mucho más que recibir el sacramento de la Confirmación, de la misma manera que ser cristiano es bastante más que estar bautizado.** Es bueno que comprendamos que por medio del Espíritu interiorizamos nuestra fe para que sea más que un conjunto exterior de ritos y normas. **Recibir el Espíritu de Cristo es vivir la fe según la dimensión del Evangelio que no puede ser encerrado ni en un libro, ni en un rito, ni en un código.**

Pidamos durante esta semana, el domingo en la celebración de la Ascensión y la semana que precede a Pentecostá, que el Espíritu penetre profundamente en nuestro interior, para que encontremos la manera de que la fe crezca y se adapte a las nuevas circunstancias impulsados por el gran principio del Amor.

Que la paz de Cristo y su Espíritu estén presentes en sus familias.

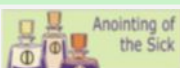
