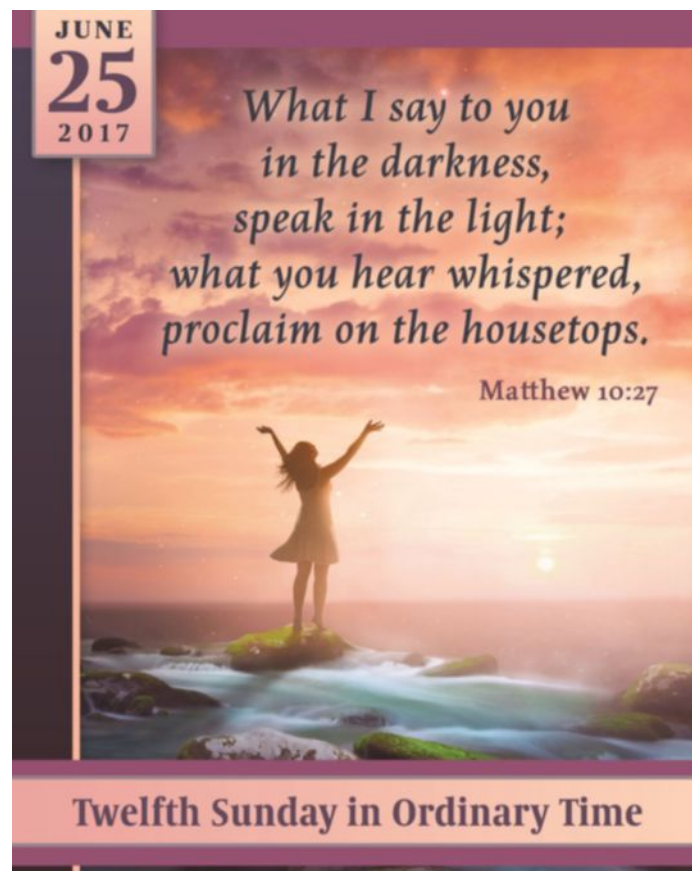

Dear Families:

Our faith becomes manifested during these difficult times of problems, doubts, persecution, and anguish. Our relationship with God is maintained by our faith. Despite of any bad influences that try to diverge us or any adversities that threaten us, God is always on our side. There are many dangers in this world today: Nations that are divided due to religious and racist issues; T.V. images that show endless calamities, wars, and natural disasters; worldly masses of people who are affected by poverty and starvation, fleeing from wars to other continents. Although this is not new, reality is that we are living in a very difficult time.

Jeremiah was a prophet of Judah during a period of political turmoil. Despite that the Emperor of Babylonia had a military agreement with the nation of Judah, Jeremiah urged the people to keep loyal to the promise of alliance that God had made with them. Jeremiah, who greatly suffered persecution because of his persistent message of repentance and conversion, was ignored by the people. Even his own family went against him. But God kept near Jeremiah and against those who plotted his death. Jeremiah always kept firm his praise and trust in God.

In today's gospel, we find a message similar to Jeremiah's. Let's not be afraid of those who can take our lives and destroy our world. Instead, our thoughts should focus on the salvation of our souls.

Because of Jesus, the love of God has restored a glimmer of hope for the world. We can live in a world that is blessed by God. We can leave to the messages of division, disasters, and wars to the light of Christ. In the light of Christ we can set aside the messages of division, misfortunes, and wars that promote evil. Let us be cultivators of peace, unity, generosity and solidarity of the love God. We shall put our complete trust in God as Jeremiah did when he relied on God as his true champion and defender.

Queridas Familias:

En tiempos de dificultades, de problemas, de dudas, de persecución y de angustia se hace más evidente la fe. Por la fe mantenemos nuestra relación con Dios, que está a nuestro lado, no importa las fuerzas del mal que tratan de desviarnos de nuestro camino y los desastres que nos amenacen. En nuestro mundo hoy hay muchas fuentes de adversidad: naciones divididas por cuestiones religiosas y raciales; imágenes en la TV de un sinnúmero de calamidades, guerras, desastres naturales; grandes masas de la población mundial afectadas por el hambre y la pobreza, huyendo de las guerras a otros continentes. Realmente vivimos tiempos difíciles, pero esto no es nuevo.

Jeremías era un profeta de Judá durante un período políticamente revuelto. A pesar de que el imperio de Babilonia tenía un tratado militar con la nación judía, Jeremías urge al pueblo para que se mantenga fiel a la alianza que Dios ha hecho con ellos. La gente ignoró a Jeremías que sufrió persecución por su persistente mensaje de arrepentimiento y conversión; incluso su misma familia se puso en contra de él. Pero Dios fue su permanente compañero contra aquellos que tramaban su muerte. Su oración a Dios y su dependencia de Dios fueron siempre firmes.

Similar a este mensaje de Jeremías lo encontramos en el evangelio de hoy. No temamos a los que pueden matar nuestros cuerpos o destruir nuestro mundo; nuestra preocupación debe ser siempre la salvación de nuestras almas.

Por Jesús, el amor de Dios ha restituido la luz y la esperanza al mundo. Podemos vivir en un mundo bendecido por Dios. A la luz de Cristo podemos dejar a un lado los mensajes de división, de desgracias, de guerras que promueve el mal. Seamos cultivadores de la paz, de la unidad; de la generosidad y solidaridad y del amor de Dios. Así como Dios fue el campeón para Jeremías que así lo sea para nosotros si ponemos nuestra confianza en Él.
