## Fourth Sunday of Easter

April 22, 2018

Act 4:8-12; 1 John 3:1-2; John 10:11-18  
Psalm 118

Dear Families:

In this Sunday's first reading, Peter's speech before the Sanhedrin, summarized here in a few sentences, presents the synthesis of the Christian message, reduced to its most central core, as initially announced by the Apostles after Pentecost: only in Jesus is salvation; to pretend to find it elsewhere, is a business doomed to failure.

In the second reading, our divine filiation is a gift of the Father's love for us (1 Jn 2, 1). Ignorance on the part of the world that we are children of God also reveals its ignorance of the Father; indeed, the two realities are intimately linked (v.1). Divine filiation is a present fact now, but it also holds a promise that will become reality only at the end of time: the similarity with God will derive from our direct view of Him, the familiar relationship with Him (v.2).

This Sunday is called Good Shepherd Sunday. The gospel we read today is very dear and beloved in the life of the Church: Jesus is the Good Shepherd. The Good Shepherd, owner of the flock, unlike the one caring for the sheep for wages, lives fully dedicated to it and spares no effort or pain to save it from danger, even at the risk of his own life (John 10: 11-13). A mutual understanding is created between the good shepherd and his sheep, similar to that which exists between the Father and the Son (vv 14-15.); for the Bible, the word "know" does not merely reference an intellectual process, but it means an intimate and familiar relationship, a presence. Jesus' mission is to bring all who are not part of it to the one flock (v. 16). The proof that Jesus is the Good Shepherd is that he freely gives his life for the sake of the sheep (vv. 17-18); For this reason the Father loves Him (v. 17).

## Cuarto Domingo de Pascua

22 de abril del 2018

Hch 4:8-12; 1 Juan 3:1-2; Juan 10:11-18  
Salmo 118 [117]

Queridas familias:

En la primera lectura de este domingo, el discurso de Pedro ante el Sanedrín, resumido aquí a unas pocas frases, nos presenta la síntesis del mensaje cristiano, reducido a su núcleo central, tal como lo anunciaban los Apóstoles al principio después de Pentecostés: Sólo en Jesús está la salvación; pretender buscarla fuera de Él, es una empresa condenada necesariamente al fracaso.

En la segunda lectura, nuestra filiación divina es un don del amor del Padre hacia nosotros (1 Jn 2, 1). La ignorancia por parte del mundo de nuestra condición de hijos de Dios revela también su ignorancia del Padre; en efecto, las dos realidades están íntimamente unidas (v.1). La filiación divina es un hecho presente ya ahora, pero al mismo tiempo encierra una promesa que será realidad solamente al final de los tiempos: la semejanza con Dios que derivará de la visión directa de Él, del trato familiar con Él (v.2).

A este domingo se le llama el domingo del Buen Pastor. El evangelio que hoy leemos es una lectura muy querida y entrañable en la vida de la Iglesia: Jesús es el Buen Pastor. El buen pastor, dueño del rebaño, a diferencia del que cuida del rebaño por un sueldo, vive totalmente entregado a él y no ahorra esfuerzos ni fatigas por salvarlo de los peligros, aun a riesgo de su propia vida (Jn 10, 11-13). Entre el buen pastor y las ovejas se crea un conocimiento mutuo, a semejanza del que existe entre el Padre y el Hijo (vv. 14-15); para la Biblia la palabra "conocer" no hace mera referencia a un proceso intelectual, sino que significa un trato íntimo y familiar, una presencia. La misión de Jesús es traer al único rebaño a todos los que no forman parte de él (v. 16). La prueba de que Jesús es el Buen Pastor está en que da su vida libremente por amor a las ovejas (vv. 17-18); por eso el Padre le ama (v. 17).
