Solemnity of the Nativity of St John the Baptist

June 24, 2018

Isaiah 49:1-6; Acts 13:22-26; Luke 1:57-66, 80
Psalm 139

Dear Families:

FOCUS: God forms and fashions each of us within our mother's womb to fulfill a unique role within his unfolding plan of salvation.

Today, Sunday, June 24th, coincides with the Solemnity of the Nativity of St. John the Baptist. Since the beginning of the Church, there are accounts of the great importance that Christians ascribed to **the birth of St. John. The reasons for such high regard are made clear in the Preface to this Mass**, regarding the wonders carried out in John the Baptist, whom God has chosen and consecrated, among those born of women, to prepare the way of Christ. Indeed, "**he leaped from joy, in the womb of his mother, at the arrival of the savior of men, and his birth was a source of joy for many. He was chosen among all prophets to show the people the lamb that takes away the sin of the world. He baptized the author of baptism in the Jordan, and water has, ever since, held saving power for men. He, in short, gave his blood as supreme testimony in the name of Christ**" He is more than a prophet (Matthew 11:9) because he not only preaches conversion, before the imminence of the kingdom of God, but also because he also announces Christ.

John the Baptist is the friend of the groom—a friend of Christ, who has come to celebrate his marriage with humanity. Christ is the lamb that is sacrificed to save the world, and John is the friend who announces him; bears witness to him; prepares hearts for his impending arrival; and dies a martyr for the kingdom of God.

This is a day of joy for Christians who have the fortune of knowing the story of the beginnings of our faith. The feast of St. John has been engraved in the history of the people. All over the world there are towns, streets, squares, rivers and cities named after **St. John**. Wherever they are, the people of Puerto Rico will never forget their beloved San Juan. From these lines we congratulate you on this great day for the island of Puerto Rico.

Truly, the feast of St. John is something very dear to many people. The reasons are in these two messages from the Bible: **John is the precursor of the Messiah, who has prepared the "way of salvation", before His coming, and he is also the prophet "who announced the lamb that was to take away the sins of the world"**.

Solemnidad de la Natividad de San Juan Bautista

Queridas familias:

ENFOQUE: Dios forma y modela a cada uno de nosotros dentro del útero de nuestra madre para cumplir un papel único dentro de su plan de salvación en desarrollo.

Hoy domingo 24 de junio coincide con la solemnidad del Nacimiento de San Juan Bautista. Desde los comienzos de la Iglesia se tiene noticia de la gran importancia que los cristianos dieron al **acontecimiento del nacimiento de San Juan. En el Prefacio de esta Misa aparecen las razones de esta alta consideración:** las maravillas operadas en Juan Bautista que Dios ha elegido y consagrado entre los nacimientos de mujer para preparar el camino de Cristo. En efecto **saltó de alegría en el vientre de su madre al llegar el Salvador de los hombres, y su nacimiento fue motivo de gozo para muchos. El fue escogido entre todos los profetas para mostrar a las gentes el Cordero que quita el pecado del mundo. El bautizó en el Jordán al autor del Bautismo, y el agua tiene desde entonces poder de salvación para los hombres. El, en fin, dio su sangre como supremo testimonio por el nombre de Cristo** El es más que profeta (Mateo 11:9) porque no sólo predica la conversión ante la inminencia del reino de Dios, sino que anuncia también a Cristo.

Juan Bautista es el amigo del esposo—amigo de Cristo que ha venido a celebrar su boda con la humanidad. Cristo es el Cordero que se sacrifica para salvar al mundo. Y Juan es el amigo que le anuncia, da testimonio de él, prepara los corazones para su inminente venida y muere martir por causa del reino de Dios.

Este es día de gozo para los cristianos que tenemos la dicha de conocer esta historia de los comienzos de nuestra fe. La fiesta de San Juan ha quedado grabada en la historia de los pueblos: por todo el mundo hay pueblos, calles, plazas, ríos y ciudades con el nombre de **San Juan**. Los puertorriqueños nunca olvidarán, están donde están, a su San Juan que tanto amaron. Desde estas líneas los felicitamos en este gran día de la isla de Puerto Rico.

En verdad que la fiesta de San Juan es algo entrañable para muchas gentes. Las razones están en estos dos mensajes de la Biblia: **Juan es el precursor del Mesías, que ha preparado la senda de la salvación antes de su venida, y es el profeta que anunció el cordero que habló de quitar el pecado del mundo**

June 29 is the Feast of **St. Peter and St. Paul**, two grand pillars of the nascent Church. Both gave their lives for Christ. It is a day to pray, especially for the Holy Father, Pope Francis and our Bishops.

May God protect and enlighten the Pope in his mission to guide the Church of the elect of the Lord - we, who are his people.

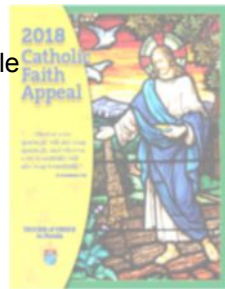

Share the Journey Continues - The Diocese of Venice continues to promote "Share the Journey", a worldwide two-year initiative of Pope Francis. The Diocese continues to run a series in the Mustard Seed designed to answer questions focusing more specifically on Refugee Resettlement. This will serve as an aide to build bridges of reconciliation, understanding and hospitality, in keeping with the spirit of Share the Journey. The topics covered include: "What Does the Gospel Say About Refugees?", "What is the Economic Impact?" and "Are Refugees a Burden?", etc.


Below is the sixth of the series for ALL PARISHES

What Do Other Countries Do?

1. Historically, the U.S. has maintained a resettlement program and has welcomed three million refugees since 1975. While the U.S. has the largest resettlement program, 28 other nations also resettle refugees. During 2015-16, Germany has resettled 456,023 Syrian refugees. The U.S. has resettled 18,007 Syrian refugees. Sources: UNHCR, Migration Policy Institute, The U.S. Office of Refugee Resettlement
2. The lion share of refugees are either internally displaced in war-torn countries or seek safety in host countries. Lebanon, for example, currently hosts over one million refugees fleeing the Syrian conflict, which amounts to about 1 refugee for every 5 people in Lebanon. Source: Amnesty International.
3. The refugee crisis is a global crisis. In addition to providing aid and resettlement, U.S. involvement is key to facilitating the stability of the regions where these crises are occurring.

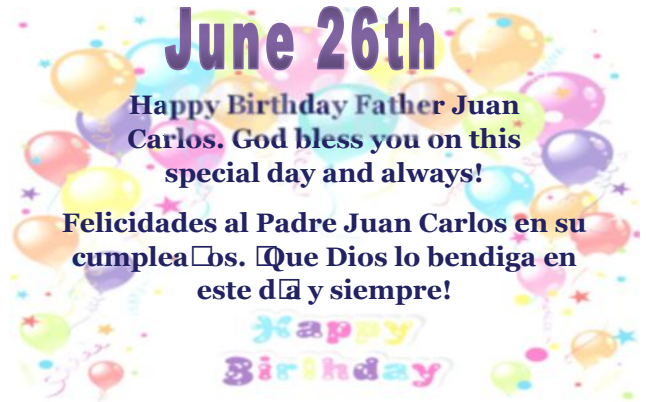
