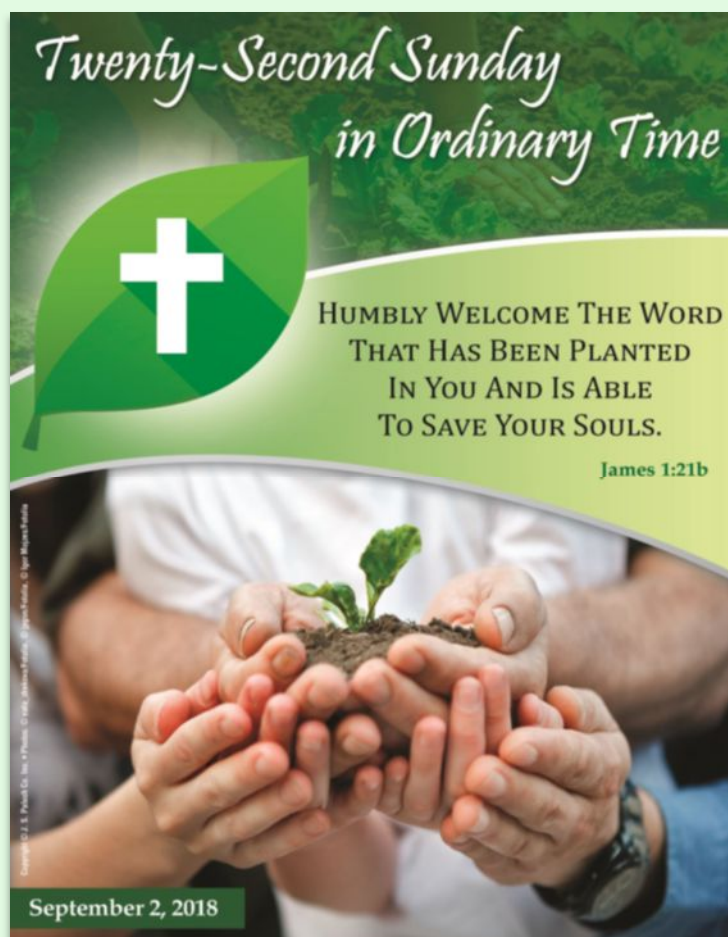

Psalm 15

Dear Families:

This people honor me with their lips, but their hearts are far from me; In vain do they worship me, teaching as doctrines human precepts. (Mark 7:6-7)

These words that Jesus spoke to the Pharisees also speak to us, today. Although the Pharisees were people who wanted to comply with the law of God throughout their lives, they forgot the spirit of the law. They blindly clung to the words, failing to fulfill what God really wanted. They reduced the practice of religion to external rites, multiplying human precepts and forgetting God's commandments. This caused many to fall into what we call hypocrisy; that is, to pretend to be what we are not - to perform external works in a mechanical and routine way without the corresponding conviction and personal commitment.

Jesus does not value external appearances, but is, rather, concerned with what's on the inside - the intentions of the heart, good faith, fairness and honesty. **"I'm not like you," says God to the prophet Samuel, "you, who are impressed by appearances. I look at the heart."**

The Pharisees were concerned excessively over external standards, forgetting the personal relationship with God and with one another. They believed that they were better than others and that they would be saved merely by their external deeds and formalities.

Performing rites is not enough. Complying with the law just, for the sake of compliance, and fulfilling a duty, just for duty's sake, is not enough. The prophets of the Old Testament constantly rebuked the people of Israel for being content with exterior religious rites and formulas that did not come from the heart.

We too can fall into the same trap - holding to our religion in a superficial way, without living it through commitments to our brethren - closed in our own selfishness. What really matters to God is that we learn to live the Gospel with faithfulness to Him, and through Him to our neighbors.

Let us remember that, on the last day, we will be judged not by our rituals, but by our love.

Vigésimo Segundo Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

2 de Septiembre del 2018

Deu 4:1-2, 6-8; Santiago 1:17-18, 21b-22, 27; Mc 7:1-8, 14-15, 21-23

Salmo 15 [14]

Queridas familias:

Este pueblo me honra con los labios, pero su corazón está lejos de mí. Es inútil el culto que rinden. Porque enseñan doctrinas que no son sino preceptos humanos. (Mc. 7:6-7)

Estas palabras que Jesús dirigió a los Fariseos pueden decirnos algo a nosotros hoy. Los Fariseos eran hombres preocupados por querer cumplir con la ley de Dios en toda su vida, pero llegaron a olvidar el espíritu de la ley, y aferrados ciegamente a las palabras, dejaron de cumplir lo que Dios realmente quería. Redujeron la práctica de la religión a puros ritos externos, multiplicando los preceptos humanos y olvidando los mandamientos de Dios. Esto provocó que muchos cayeran en lo que llamamos hipocresía, que es aparentar lo que no somos; hacer obras externas de un modo mecánico y rutinario, sin que estas correspondan en realidad a una convicción y a un compromiso personal en todo lo que se hace.

Jesús no valora las apariencias de las personas, sino su interior: las intenciones del corazón, la buena fe, la rectitud, la honradez. **Yo no soy como te dice Dios al profeta Samuel, que te dejaste impresionar por las apariencias: Yo miro al corazón.**

Los Fariseos se preocupaban excesivamente de normas externas, olvidando el acercamiento personal a Dios y a los hombres, y creían ser mejores que los demás. Creían que con la práctica de las formalidades estaban a salvo.

No basta el rito, cumplir los mandamientos por cumplir, el deber por el deber. Los profetas del Antiguo Testamento reprendieron constantemente al pueblo de Israel por contentarse con una religiosidad exterior de fórmulas y ritos, no del corazón.

Nosotros podemos caer en el mismo error: vivir la religión de esa manera sin compromisos con nuestros hermanos; cerrados en nuestro egoísmo. Lo que realmente vale es vivir el Evangelio con fidelidad a Dios y al prójimo.

Pensemos que en el último día seremos juzgados no por los ritos, sino por el amor.

Que Dios los Bendiga.

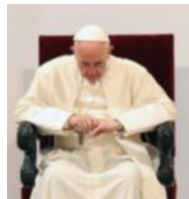

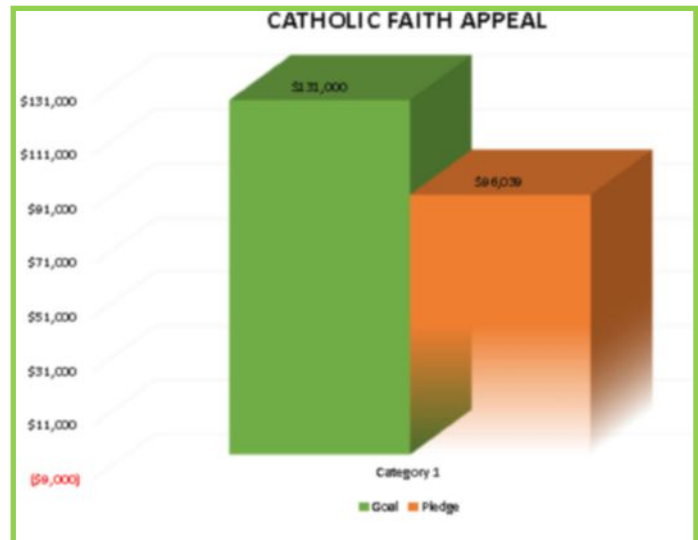
