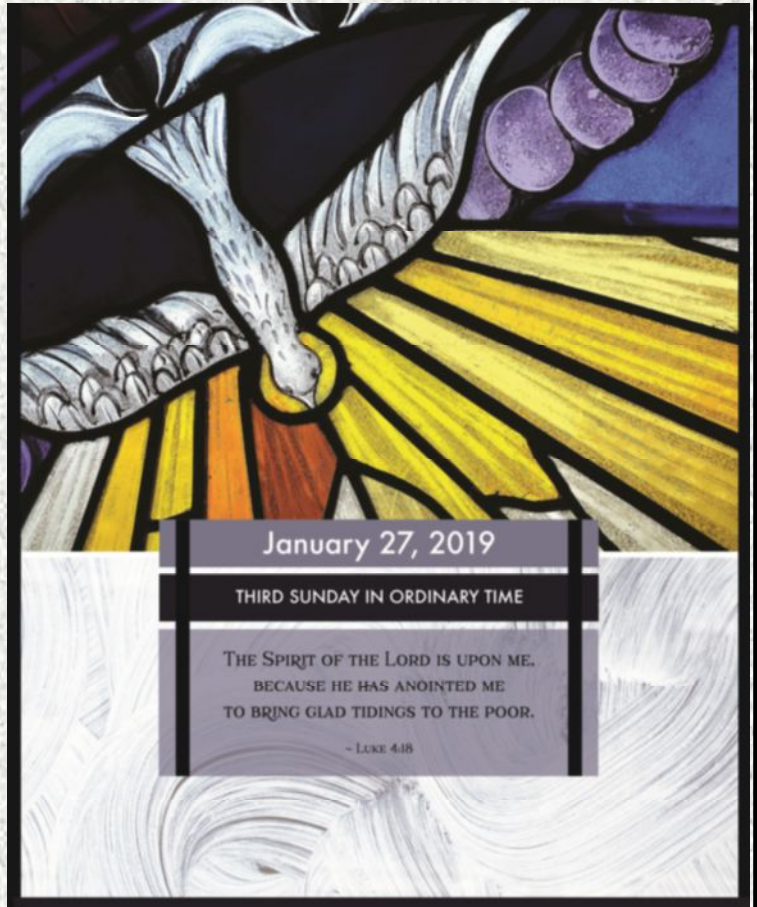

Third Sunday in Ordinary Time

January 27, 2019

Nehemiah 8:2-4a, 5-6, 8-10; 1 Cor 12:12-30; Luke 1:1-4; 4:14-21
Psalm 19

Dear Families:

In this Sunday Gospel, we hear Jesus saying firmly: **"Today this Scripture passage is fulfilled in your hearing; of what prophecies does Jesus speak? of the prophet Isaiah: 'The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he has anointed me to bring glad tidings to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim liberty to captives and recovery of sight to the blind, to let the oppressed go free, and to proclaim a year acceptable to the Lord.'"**

With this solemn announcement is how Jesus presented himself in Nazareth. He is the awaited Savior - He who brings "a year acceptable to the Lord," that is, the full forgiveness and reconciliation with God. It is the end of humanity being isolated from God and the beginning of a new humanity, reconciled in Christ. This is why Jesus came. Our mission is not only to listen to this message, but to convey that Jesus' announcement is being fulfilled. God wants a world reconciled with Him and at peace with one another; a free world; respectful, free nations, without wars, without dictators, guerrillas, drugs, or terrorism; a world in which children are open to life and growth, like flowers in spring, full of colors and beautiful visions, without fear and pain; a world of brothers and sisters. We must bear witness to all this that Jesus came to leave us: He is merciful. Let us come to Him for His mercy.

We still have to learn to live in difficult times, with the hope that it will soon pass. Jesus teaches us to keep love in the home; to keep solidarity with those most in need; to remain in confident prayer; and, every day, to turn our gaze to God, never forgetting that we cannot do it, without Him.

May God show mercy on us. May He enlighten the minds and move the wills of those who have the power and ability to generate peace and prevent war; celebrate life and not death; give hope, and help the people achieve their dreams. This is what Jesus wants. He places this work in our hands; with His help, we are to develop a world that is more humane, more Christian, and more of God. A world that tries to do without God has no hope.

Saturday, February 2nd is **The Feast of the Presentation of the Lord, also known as Candlemas, the Feast of the Purification of the Virgin, or Our Lady of Candelaria**. It is one of the oldest feasts of the Catholic Church (IV century). It is the day that the Virgin Mary and St. Joseph present their son, Jesus, to God. Old Simeon is filled with joy because God visited his people, bringing the salvation to him, in his old age. Through him, we contemplate the fact that God himself, the living and true God, is radically committed to humanity ("God-with-us"). Simeon prophesizes about the child, showing the mystery of his passion, death and resurrection.

It is also called the Feast of the Purification of Our Lady because according to Jewish custom, women had to wait 40 days after giving birth to return to the temple. On that occasion, she must fulfill the offering prescribed by law. The Virgin Mary was, naturally, a part of the religious society of her time.

Tercer Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

Salmo 19 [18]

Queridas familias:

En el evangelio que leemos en este domingo escuchamos a Jesús que dice con firmeza: **"Hoy se cumplen estas profecías que acaban de escuchar"** ¿de qué profecías habla Jesús de las del profeta Isaías: **"El Espíritu del Señor está sobre mí, por el que me consagró. Me envió a traer la Buena Nueva a los pobres, a anunciar a los cautivos la libertad y a los ciegos la vista, para dar la libertad a los oprimidos y proclamar un año de gracia del Señor"**

Así fue como Jesús se presentó en Nazaret e hizo este solemne anuncio. Él es el Salvador esperado. El que nos trae un año de gracia del Señor, es decir, el perdón y la reconciliación total con Dios. Termina la situación de la humanidad aislada de Dios y comienza una nueva humanidad reconciliada en Cristo. Para esto ha venido Jesús. A nosotros nos toca la misión no solo de escuchar este mensaje sino de transmitir que ya se cumple lo que Jesús anunció. Dios quiere un mundo reconciliado con Él y en paz unos con otros; un mundo libre, de respeto, naciones libres, sin guerras, sin dictadores, sin guerrillas, sin narcotráfico, sin terrorismo; un mundo en el que los niños se abran a la vida, a su crecimiento, como las flores en primavera, llenos de colores e ilusiones sin miedos y sin dolor. Un mundo de hermanos. Debemos ser testigos de esto que Jesús vino a dejarnos: Es misericordioso. Acercámonos a Él buscando su misericordia.

Nos queda aprender a vivir en tiempos difíciles con la esperanza de que pasen pronto. Jesús nos enseña a mantener el amor en el hogar, la solidaridad con los que más lo necesitan y la oración confiada de cada día para que volvamos la mirada a Dios, de quien pretendamos prescindir.

Que Dios se muestre misericordioso con nosotros, que ilumine las mentes y mueva las voluntades de los que tienen el poder y la capacidad de generar paz y no guerra, vida y no muerte, ilusión, esperanza y sueños realizables.

Esto es lo que quiere Jesús que estén en nuestras manos trabajar con la ayuda de Él para que haya un mundo más humano, más cristiano, más de Dios. El mundo de los que prescinden de Dios no tiene esperanza.

El sábado 2 de febrero es **la fiesta de la Presentación del Señor. También se llama a este día la fiesta de la Purificación o Virgen de la Candelaria**. Es una de las fiestas más antigua de la Iglesia Católica (Siglo IV). Es el día en que la Virgen María y San José presentan ante Dios a su hijo Jesús. El viejo Simeón se llena de alegría, porque Dios visitó a su pueblo, trayendo la salvación que él ya en edad avanzada, puede contemplar. El propio Dios, Dios vivo y verdadero, Dios-con-nosotros, se compromete radicalmente con la humanidad. Simeón profetiza sobre el niño, mostrando el misterio de su pasión, muerte y resurrección.

Se llama también la fiesta de la Purificación de Nuestra Señora porque según la costumbre judía, solamente 40 días después del parto la mujer podía frecuentar de nuevo el templo. En esa ocasión debía cumplir la ofrenda prescrita por la ley. La Virgen María estaba perfectamente insertada en la sociedad religiosa de su tiempo.

GOOD HEALTH HABITS CAN STOP GERMS

- 1. Avoid close contact.** Avoid close contact with people who are sick.
- 2. Stay home when you are sick.** If possible, stay home from work, school, and errands when you are sick.
- 3. Cover your mouth and nose.** Cover your mouth and nose with a tissue when coughing or sneezing. It may prevent those around you from getting sick.
- 4. Clean your hands.** Washing your hands often will help protect you from germs. If soap and water are not available, use an alcohol-based hand rub.
- 5. Avoid touching your eyes, nose or mouth.** Germs are often spread when a person touches something that is contaminated with germs and then touches his or her eyes, nose, or mouth.
- 6. Practice other good health habits.** Clean and disinfect frequently touched surfaces at home, work or school, especially when someone is ill. Get plenty of sleep, be physically active, manage your stress, drink plenty of fluids, and eat nutritious food.

LOS BUENOS HABITOS PUEDEN PREVENIR LOS GERMENES

- 1. Evite el contacto cercano.** Evite el contacto cercano con personas enfermas.
- 2. Permanezca en casa cuando esté enfermo.** Si es posible, quédese en casa, no vaya al trabajo, a la escuela ni a las diligencias cuando esté enfermo.
- 3. Cubra su boca y nariz.** Al toser o estornudar, cubra su boca y nariz con un pañuelo desechable. Esto puede impedir que los que le rodean se enfermen.
- 4. Límpiase las manos.** Lavarse las manos frecuentemente le ayudará a protegerse de los gérmenes. Si no hay agua y jabón disponible, utilice un desinfectante para manos a base de alcohol.
- 5. Evite tocarse los ojos, nariz o boca.** Los gérmenes a menudo se propagan cuando una persona toca algo contaminado con gérmenes y luego se toca sus ojos, nariz o boca.
- 6. Practique otros buenos hábitos de salud.** Limpie y desinfecte las superficies que se tocan con frecuencia en el hogar, el trabajo o la escuela, especialmente cuando alguien está enfermo. Duerma lo suficiente, manténgase físicamente activo, controle su estrés, tome muchos líquidos y coma alimentos nutritivos.
