## Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time

February 10, 2019

isaiah 6:1-2a, 3-8; 1 Cor 15:1-11 [3-8,11]; Lk 5:1-11  
Psalm 138

Dear Families:

**1<sup>st</sup> Reading:** Seated on His throne, surrounded by angels, who proclaim His Holiness by saying: "Holy, Holy, Holy is the Lord of hosts (Yahweh Sabaoth), all the earth is filled with His glory." Yahweh appears to Isaiah, who is destined for a great mission. Before the presence of Yahweh, three times Holy, the prophet feels that he is a man of unclean lips. Then one of the seraphim flew to him, holding an ember that he had taken with tongs from the altar, he touched his mouth with it, and said, "See, now that this has touched your lips, your wickedness is removed, your sin purged." (The prophet is sanctified with the holiness of Yahweh, as the ember is holy because it participates in holiness that the altar transmits).

**2<sup>nd</sup> Reading:** The second reading contains a Kerygmatic synthesis of Paul (1<sup>st</sup> announcement of the Good News); and not only Paul, but the apostolic Kerygma. These elements of the Kerygma were: announcement of the Lord's Death, according to the Scriptures; Burial; Resurrection; Exaltation to the Right Hand of the Father; witnesses of the Resurrection; call to conversion. Faith is based on these historical events: The Death, Resurrection and Ascension of the Lord. These events become current and personal in the Christian community and in each of its members.

**This Sunday:** The Church invites us to trust, always. We have all gone through situations similar to those endured by the disciples of Jesus. We struggle and strive, only to see little results. Many times we give up. What is surprising about this Gospel story is that the disciples, despite having fished all night and caught nothing, simply **trusted in Jesus**. They cast their fishing nets again, "**in his name**". Another detail worthy of contemplation is that they are together, in community, not each one for himself.

Sometimes we feel alone, isolated, without friends, or support. We plan projects and have dreams that we work so hard to fulfill; we have expectations for our children that never materialize. There are many circumstances that push us to feel defeated. The message of the Gospel invites us to put aside "the night without fish"; to let go of what seems to be past failures; to forget about our disappointed expectations (often built upon our own elusions). Instead, we should concentrate on the present reality, and look to the future with trust, hope, and joy. Let Christ into your life with His Word and Sacraments of life. Let Him be your daily draught of light. Let Him into your heart, every day and night, to shape your thoughts and dreams, giving true and real meaning to your projects. **"Cast the nets again"; trust Him; and be guided by Him.**

Queridas familias:

**1<sup>o</sup> Lectura:** A Isa'as, destinado para una gran misi3n, se le aparece Yahv3 sentado en su trono, rodeado de 3ngeles, que proclaman su santidad diciendo: Santo, Santo, Santo, Yahv3 Sabaoth. Llena est3a tierra de tu gloria. Ante Yahv3 tres veces Santo, el profeta se siente de labios impuros, pero un seraf'n (3ngel) coge una brasa del altar, la pone en su boca y el profeta queda libre de culpa, santificado con la santidad de Yahv3 pues la brasa es santa porque participa de la santidad que trasmite el altar.

**2<sup>o</sup> Lectura:** La segunda lectura contiene una s'ntesis Kerigm3tica de Pablo (1er anuncio de la buena nueva), y no s3lo de Pablo, sino el Kerigma apost3lico. Estos elementos del Kerigma eran: anuncio de la muerte del Se-or, seg3n las Escrituras; sepultura; resurrecci3n; exaltaci3n a la derecha del Padre; testigos de la resurrecci3n; llamada a la conversi3n. La fe se fundamenta sobre estos acontecimientos hist3ricos: la Muerte, Resurrecci3n, y Ascensi3n del Se-or. Estos acontecimientos se hacen actuales y personales en la comunidad cristiana y en cada uno de sus miembros.

**En este domingo** la Iglesia nos invita a confiar siempre. A todos nos ha ocurrido alguna vez lo mismo que a los disc'pulos de Jes3s. Luchamos, nos esforzamos y al final vemos pocos resultados. Muchas veces nos damos por vencidos. Lo sorprendente del relato de este evangelio es que los disc'pulos a pesar de haber pasado toda la noche sin pescar nada, simplemente se f'an **conf'an de Jes3s** y **en su nombre** echan las redes de pescar de nuevo. Otro detalle para la reflexi3n es que est3n juntos, en comunidad, no est3 cada uno por su lado.

A veces nos sentimos solos, aislados, sin amigos, sin apoyo. Nos planteamos proyectos, con ilusi3n trabajamos por conseguir algo, esperamos de los hijos algo que despu3 no llega. Son muchas las circunstancias que nos empujan a sentirnos derrotados. El mensaje de este evangelio nos invita a dejar a un lado 3a noche sin pescar. A dejar a un lado lo que nos parecen fracasos, a olvidar aquello que eran simplemente ilusiones y concentrarnos en el presente y mirar hacia el futuro. Deja a Cristo que entre en tu vida con su palabra y con sus sacramentos de vida. El es tu luz de cada d'a para moldear tus pensamientos, tus ilusiones, y dar forma real y verdadera a tus proyectos. **Echa las redes de nuevo. conf'a en El y d3jate guiar por El.**

## From the Office of the Bishop

### Statement from Bishop Frank J. Dewane Responding to "No-Limit Abortion" Law in New York

Let us be reminded that all Life begins at the moment of Conception, which for Catholics is not in dispute despite any new laws such as the recent law passed in New York State and introduced in the Virginia State Legislature.

Regarding abortion, the Catechism of the Catholic Church states: "Human life must be respected and protected absolutely from the moment of conception. From the first moment of his existence, a human being must be recognized as having the rights of a person - among which is the inviolable right of every innocent being to life. Since the first century the Church has affirmed the moral evil of every procured abortion. This teaching has not changed and remains unchangeable. Direct abortion, that is to say, abortion willed either as an end or a means, is gravely contrary to the moral law." (2270-2271)

This should remind us that the killing of an innocent child through abortion is abhorrent. It is natural to want to speak out about such egregiousness, but first all are called to pray for an end to the scourge that is abortion. Pray also that our legislators and judges at the state and national levels stop celebrating laws that will end the life of a child.

If you disagree with laws such as the one recently passed in New York State, please write to your state and federal politicians to share your thoughts, disagreement and disgust on this critical issue. Meaningful change pertaining to this matter will not come until all stand together to give a voice to the voiceless, the vulnerable unborn children who in some places can now potentially face death up until the moment of their birth.
