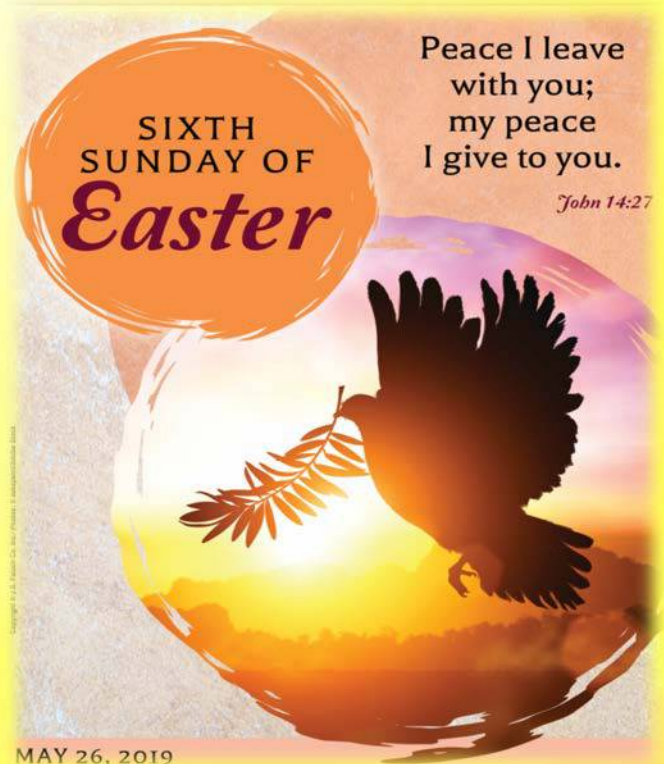

Dear families:

“I give you peace, not as the world gives peace.” I do not know what kind of peace the world gives, but if it secures the future with pension plans and all sorts of material security, such peace may not last nor is it deeply satisfying. That peace falters when there are difficulties; it seeks a way out of conflicts, and escapes commitments when things get ugly. It's the kind of peace so fleeting that it easily resorts to a breakup, a divorce or a job change, when something goes wrong, severing the relationship rather than engaging in dialogue. That peace does not warrant the kind of peace of which Jesus spoke, a peace that is profound, stable, enduring, and unaltered, no matter how bad external conditions surrounding us may seem.

The peace of Jesus is the peace of those who know the end of the story. And the end of the story (as in fairy tales, but even better) is that good always triumphs over evil. Always. We may be dealing with illness, unemployment, violence, war and death. We may be facing serious problems within our family, tensions or differences in mentality and customs in our communities. And yet we know that the truth of Christ is much more powerful than all the lies and death and wars in this world. To seek this peace is not to escape the reality of the world and close our eyes to what is happening around us, but rather, it is a journey to an interior point of encounter with God, in which you will find peace and strength to fight what you can fight for or against, and to accept that against which you can not do anything. It consists, above all, to live and walk in the deepest truth of God.

When we walk with God it is not easy to walk away to seek our own peace. When we walk with God, we walk with our best friend, who listens to us and comforts us. God promised Abraham and Moses: "I am with you." The angel said to Mary, "The Lord is with you", even though she had no idea that, from that moment on, every step she took would be with the Son of God growing in her womb. If we walk with God we walk with a peace that can not be shattered.

Queridas familias:

“Les doy la paz, pero no como la da el mundo.” No sé qué clase de paz da el mundo, pero si es la que asegura el futuro con planes de pensiones y toda suerte de seguridades materiales, puede que tal paz no dure ni satisfaga profundamente. Esa paz se tambalea cuando hay dificultades, busca salir de los conflictos, escapa de los compromisos cuando las cosas se ponen feas. Es el tipo de paz tan pasajera que recurre a la facilidad de una ruptura, un divorcio o un cambio de trabajo en cuanto pasa algo, o a romper las relaciones en lugar de dialogar. Esa paz no garantiza el tipo de paz de la que habla Jesús, que es una paz profunda, estable, duradera, y que no se altera por muy malas que parezcan las condiciones externas.

La paz de Jesús es la paz de quien conoce bien el final de la historia. Y el final de la historia, lo mismo que en las novelas, pero incluso mejor, es que triunfa el bien siempre por encima del mal. Siempre. Podemos estar enfrentándonos a enfermedades, falta de trabajo, violencia, guerra y muerte. Podemos estar enfrentándonos a problemas muy serios dentro de nuestra familia, o a tensiones por las diferencias de mentalidad o costumbres en nuestras comunidades. Y, sin embargo, sabemos que la verdad de Cristo es mucho más poderosa que toda la mentira y la muerte y las guerras de este mundo. Buscar esta paz no consiste en escapar de la realidad del mundo ni cerrar los ojos a lo que está sucediendo, sino viajar a un punto interior de encuentro con Dios en el que se encuentra la paz y la fuerza para luchar contra lo que se puede luchar, y aceptar aquello contra lo que no se puede hacer nada. Consiste, sobre todo, en vivir en la más profunda verdad de Dios.

Cuando caminamos con Dios no es fácil alejarnos para buscar nuestra propia paz. Cuando caminamos con Dios, caminamos con nuestro mejor amigo quien nos escucha y nos consuela. Dios le prometió a Abraham y a Moisés: “Estaré con ustedes”. El ángel le dijo a María: “El Señor está contigo”, aún cuando ella no tenía ni la menor idea de que a partir de ese momento cada paso que diera, sería con el Hijo de Dios creciendo en su vientre. Si caminamos con Dios caminamos con una paz que no puede ser destruida.

Que Dios los bendiga.
