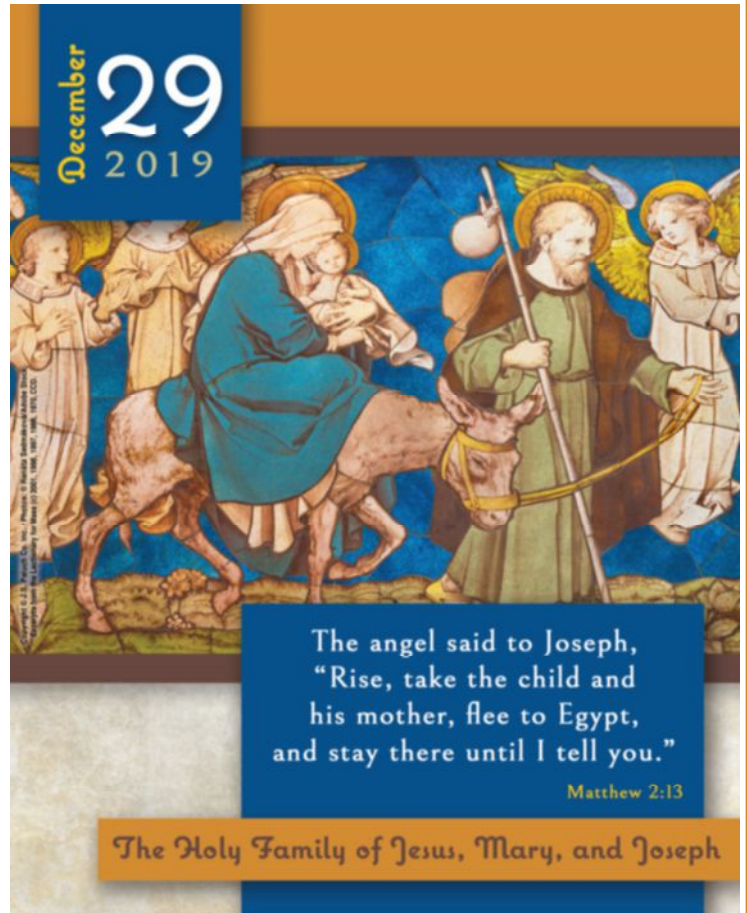

Feast of the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary and Joseph

December 29, 2019

Sirach 3:2-6, 12-14; Colossians 3:12-21; Matthew 2-13-15

Psalm 128

Dear families:

Today, the Sunday, after Christmas, the Church invites us to contemplate the newborn Jesus within the framework of the family, as an example to all Christians.

Three thoughts should be kept in mind, as we contemplate today's readings:

-The passage from Sirach emphasizes the divine origin of the authority of parents, and the blessings God promises to those children who accept and fulfill the commandment to "honor thy father and mother." In honoring our parents, we are honoring God.

-The family code that St. Paul gives us, in his letter to the Colossians, constitutes an ideal program of coexistence within the Christian family. It is not about the wife being submissive to her husband, as if she were a slave. Rather, it is to bring harmony to the marriage. As Christ loves his Church, so should the husband and wife love each other.

-The compound task assigned to Joseph, by God, in a dream ("...rise; take the child and his mother; flee to Egypt...rise; take the child and his mother and go to the land of Israel...") was implemented, in a most literal sense, by Joseph: "...Joseph rose and took the child and his mother; and fled into Egypt...Joseph rose, took the child and his mother, and returned to the land of Israel...". This serves to illustrate the active role (and authority) exerted by the father, for the good of his family.

Parents, as leaders of families, must realize that, despite all the buffers and services of modern civilization, they cannot leave the defense of their families and the education of their children to others. God gave parents the right to exercise certain authority, whenever necessary. Today, let the parents among us ask the Lord, through the intercession of the Holy Family, for the strength and wisdom to fulfill their duty. May they not contribute, as a result of their inhibitions, to the deterioration of the institution of the family, which is rapidly becoming prevalent, in the world.

Peace and Love, in the name of God, for your families.

May God bless you.

Tres pensamientos merecen ser destacados en las lecturas de hoy:

-El pasaje de Eclesiástico recalca el origen divino de la autoridad de los padres y las bendiciones que Dios promete a los hijos que la acepten y que cumplen el mandamiento de: Honrar padre y madre. Honrar a nuestros padres es como si honramos a Dios.

-El código familiar que San Pablo nos brinda en la carta a los Colosenses constituye un programa ideal de la convivencia en el seno de la familia cristiana. No se piense que la esposa debe estar sumisa al marido como si fuera su esclava, sino que se trata de que veamos la armonía en el matrimonio; así como Cristo ama a su Iglesia, de la misma manera el esposo y la esposa deben amarse.

-El doble encargo hecho por Dios a Josu en sueños: Levántate, toma al niño y a su madre y huye a Egipto Levántate, toma al niño y a su madre y regresa a la tierra de Israel y su ejecución literal por parte de Josu: José se levantó, tomó al niño y a su madre y huyó a Egipto José se levantó, tomó al niño y a su madre y volvió a Israel subrayan el papel del padre y su autoridad para el bien de la familia.

-Los padres, por mucha modernidad que nos toque vivir no pueden dejar en manos de nadie la defensa de la familia y la educación de los hijos. A ellos ha puesto Dios para que ejerzan esta autoridad siempre que sea necesario. Pidamos hoy al Señor, por la mediación de la Sagrada Familia la fuerza necesaria para que los padres sepan cumplir con su deber. Que no contribuyan con su inhibición al deterioro que por parte del mundo está sufriendo en nuestros días la institución familiar.

Paz y Amor de parte de Dios para sus familias.

Que Dios los bendiga.

**The Octave Day of Christmas
Solemnity of the Blessed Virgin Mary
The Mother of God**

January 1, 2020

Numbers 6:22-27; Galatians 4:4-7; Luke 2:16-21, Psalm 67

Dear Families:

Today we celebrate the Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God:

Eight days after the birth of Jesus we celebrate His circumcision - the rite which God gave to Abraham and his descendants as a sign of the covenant between him and his chosen people (Gen 17:9-13; Lev 12:3), and the name that the Angel of the Annunciation spoke to Mary (Lk 1:31) and that God gave in a dream to Joseph (Mt 1:21).

That name, which in Hebrew means "God saves", is precisely appropriate for the One who would go on to "save His people from their sins" (Mt 1:21). Moreover, as St. Peter said to the Sanhedrin (Jewish Supreme Council, which decided state and religious affairs), "... there is no salvation through anyone else, nor is there any other name under heaven given to the human race, by which we are to be saved" (Acts 4:12).

Today is the day to acknowledge the meaning and scope of the name of Jesus to us all; the name given to the Son of God-made-man, on a day like today, by His biological mother (Mary) and His legal father (Joseph).

Theologically: The liturgy celebrates, on this day, the divine motherhood of Mary. St. Paul assures us, in his letter to the Galatians (today's second reading), that God sent his Son born of woman.

With the title "Mother of God," Her Son's followers greeted the Virgin Mary from the beginning of Christianity. The controversies with Nestorius, who refused this privilege to Mary in the V century, contributed to a deeper theological study of the issue, which was ultimately resolved as a dogma of faith, in the Council of Ephesus (Ecumenical III), year 431.

On that occasion the faithful accompanied the Council Fathers in a solemn procession along the great city, singing for the first time what is now the second part of the Hail Mary: "Holy Mary, Mother of God, pray for us sinners, now, and at the hour of our death" Amen.

It is true that Mary gave birth only to the human nature that the Word of God informed. However, inasmuch as human generation always ends in person, and since, in Christ, there is no human person, but only the second person of the Holy Trinity, it follows that the motherhood of Mary ends in God, and therefore, she is rightly called the Mother of God. From this fact, proceeds the very special dignity of Mary.

Luckily for us, Jesus proclaimed her, from the cross: Mother of all the baptized. It is logical that today we thank God for having elevated Mary to the rank of Mother of God, and we also thank Him for giving her to us, as our Mother.

Today the Church celebrates World Day of Peace. Jesus is the most effective promoter of peace (among men). Peace behind God's back is a utopia. If men are not made right with God (in good standing with God), the causes of strife and war will not disappear. Working for the reconciliation of man with God is our best pacifist campaign. Let us pray that our actions will be guided by His grace and subject to His will.

The end of a year must be for us an occasion of thanksgiving for the gifts received and the opportunity to ask forgiveness for our ingratitude to God's love.

The beginning of the year invites us to reform our goal to be better, and ask for us and for all God's blessing; the blessing that God taught Moses and Aaron, as stated in today's first reading: "The Lord bless you and keep you, The Lord shine His face upon you and be gracious to you; the Lord look upon you kindly and grant you peace" (Numbers 6:24-26).

Let us pray with Zechariah: "... That we see the star of the Messiah, to shine on those who sit in darkness and death's shadow, to guide our steps into the path of peace" (Luke 1:78-79).

**La Octava de Navidad
Solemnidad de Santa Mara, Madre de Dios**

1 de enero del 2020

Numeros 6:22-27; Golatas 4:4-7; Lucas 2:16-21, Salmo 67

Queridas Familias:

Hoy celebramos la Solemnidad de Santa Mara, Madre de Dios:

A los ocho das del nacimiento de Jesus celebramos su circuncision, el rito que Dios impuso a Abraham y su descendencia como signo de la alianza establecida entre el y el pueblo elegido (Gen 17:9-13; Lev 12:3), y la imposicion del nombre que el angel de la Anunciacion indico Mara (Lc 1:31) y Dios, en sueos, a Joseph (Mt 1:21).

Ese nombre, que en hebreo significa "Dios Salva" corresponde exactamente al que salvara su pueblo de sus pecados (Mt 1:21), porque, como dirio San Pedro a los del Sanedron (Consejo Supremo de los Judeos que trataba y decida a los asuntos de Estado y de Religion) "No hay salvacion en ninguno otro, ya que no hay bajo el cielo otro nombre dado a los hombres, por el que nosotros podamos salvarnos" (Hch 4:12).

Hoy es el da de agradecer el significado y alcance que para nosotros tiene el nombre de Jesus que al Hijo de Dios hecho hombre impusieron tal da como hoy su madre biologica (Mara) y su padre legal (Joseph).

Teologicamente: La liturgia celebra este da la maternidad divina de Mara. Nos asegura San Pablo en la carta a los Golatas (segunda lectura de hoy), que Dios envio su hijo nacido de mujer.

Con el titulo de Madre de Dios saluda la Virgen la piedad de los seguidores de su Hijo a partir de los comienzos del cristianismo. Las controversias con Nestorio, que en el siglo V negaba a Mara este privilegio, contribuyeron a que se profundizara teologicamente este tema, que por fimo fue definido como dogma de fe en el Concilio de Efeso (III Ecumenico) el ao 431.

En aquella ocasion el pueblo fiel acompaa a los padres conciliares en una solemne procesion, que recorrio la gran ciudad cantando por primera vez lo que hoy es la segunda parte del Avemara: "Santa Mara, Madre de Dios, ruega por nosotros pecadores ahora y en la hora de nuestra muerte. Amen".

Es cierto que Mara solo engendro la naturaleza humana que el Verbo de Dios hizo suya. Pero la generacion humana termina siempre en persona. Y puesto que en Cristo no hay persona humana, sino solo la segunda persona de la Santisima Trinidad, la maternidad de Mara termina en Dios y, por eso, con todo derecho es llamada Madre de Dios. De ahi proviene la especialisima dignidad de Mara.

Para suerte nuestra, Jesus desde la cruz la proclamo Madre de todos los bautizados. Es logico que hoy agradezcamos a Dios el haber elevado a Mara a la categoria de Madre suya y le agradezcamos tambien habernosla dado por Madre a nosotros.

Hoy la Iglesia celebra la Jornada Mundial de la Paz. Jesus es el magificaz promotor de la paz horizontal (entre los hombres). La paz horizontal de espaldas a Dios es una utopia. Si los hombres no se ponen a bien con Dios, no desapareceran las causas de las disensiones y de las guerras. Trabajar por la reconciliacion de los hombres con Dios es nuestra mejor campaa pacifista. Pidamos a Dios que lo sepamos hacer, viviendo todos en gracia de Dios y sometidos a su voluntad.

El final de un ao deber ser para nosotros motivo de accion de gracias por los bienes recibidos y ocasion para pedir perdon por nuestra mala correspondencia al amor de Dios.

El principio de ao nos invita a reformar nuestro proposito de ser mejores, y a pedir para nosotros y para todos la bendicion divina, esa bendicion que Dios mismo enseo a Moises y Aaron, como leemos en la primera lectura de hoy: "El Seor te bendiga y te proteja, ilumine su rostro sobre ti y te conceda su favor; el Seor se fije en ti y te conceda la paz" (Numeros 6:24-26).

Pidamos con Zacaria: "Que nos visite la estrella del Mesas, para iluminar a los que viven en tinieblas y en sombras de muerte, para guiar nuestros pasos por el camino de la paz" (Lucas 1:78-79).

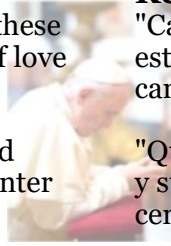


