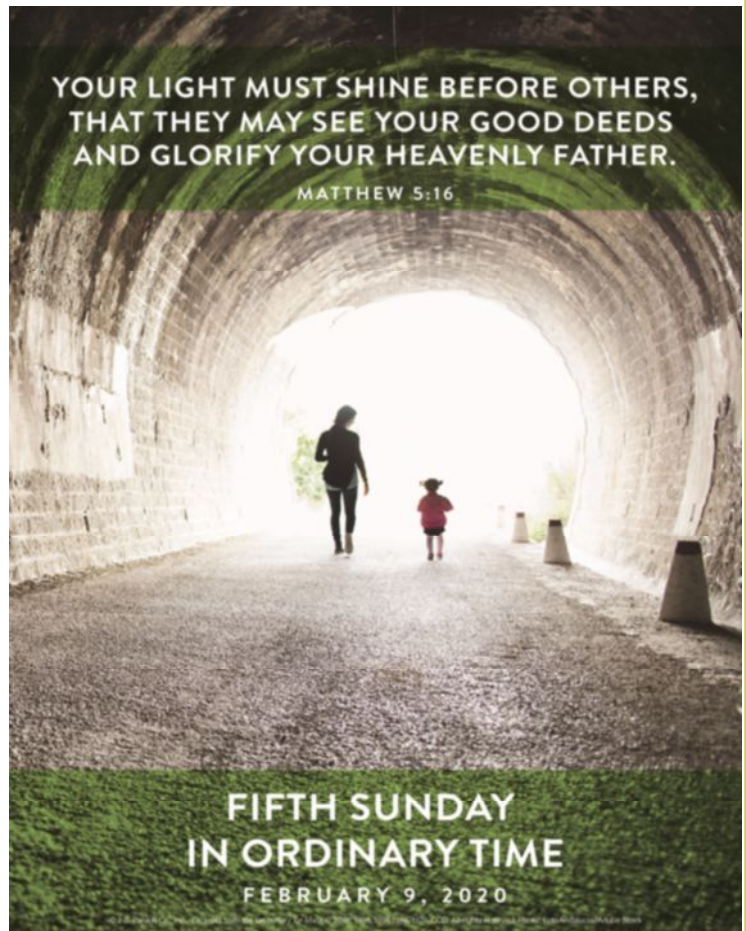

Isaiah 58:7-10; 1 Corinthians 2:1-5; Matthew 5:13-16

Psalm 112

**D**ear families:

Jesus tells us in today's Gospel: **□We are called to be salt of the earth and light of the world□** Salt is used to preserve and flavor food, heal wounds and melt ice and snow. This is how we Christians should be. It is not about doing things that are spectacular or out of the ordinary, but rather it is about bringing flavor to every day life, through setting the example by doing worthwhile things well; striving to manifest joy and peace in the family; providing Christian upbringing and a good education for the children; showing solidarity with the poor; forming and nurturing sincere friendships; and providing comfort and care to the sick and elderly.

These things have flavor, and experiencing them brings delight and pleasure to us and to those around us, because they are the things that God wants, in order for the world to have life and not death. When we find these things missing, human existence is filled with cold hearts, tasting of death and destruction, lacking soul and without God...a grim, cold, flavorless existence, indeed.

Being a light to the world is the same. Jesus employed examples and parables to engender understanding in the people. He often used different parable to teach the same principle. This is a clue, for us, suggesting how important He considered these principles. Light is familiar to us, encouraging confident action. Darkness on the other hand, makes us stand still, because without light we do not know where we are going. Light is to physical human life what faith is for the life of the soul. Being a light to the world, then, means to be men and women of faith. This faith, in turn, shining in the world, through our actions, illuminates the pathway of salvation, so that others may walk His light. In this way, we are called to be His beacons of truth and goodness, leading others out of darkness, into the light of salvation.

May the light of peace, forgiveness, generosity and patience shine in all Christians. May there be no darkness of selfishness, envy, greed and revenge. This is death and God is not there. Let us help build lives where God is at the center of everything. Through the power of God we can be a light to the world, shining with love and concern for others, especially the poor and oppressed.

**Q**ueridas familias:

Cuando estas cosas faltan nos encontramos con vidas humanas cuyos corazones parecen llenos de hielo, vidas con sabor a muerte y destrucción, vidas sin alma, vidas sin Dios.

Ser luz del mundo viene a ser lo mismo. Jesús hablaba a la gente con ejemplos. Usaba varios para explicar lo mismo, dando a entender lo importante que era el mensaje que transmitía. La luz nos es bien familiar, la oscuridad nos hace permanecer quietos, porque sin luz no sabemos a dónde vamos. La luz es para la vida humana del cuerpo lo que la fe es para la vida del alma. Ser luz entonces quiere decir ser mujeres y hombres de fe; y esta fe ilumina las acciones de nuestra vida; y esas acciones son vistas por los demás y los ayudan a caminar en la luz, es decir en la verdad, en el bien.

Que en los cristianos brille la paz, el perdón, la generosidad, la paciencia. Que no haya la oscuridad del egoísmo, la envidia, la ambición, la venganza. Esto es muerte y ahí no está Dios. Ayudemos a construir vidas donde Dios sea el centro de todo. Mediante el poder de Dios podemos ser luz para el mundo con amor y preocupación por los demás, especialmente los pobres y oprimidos.

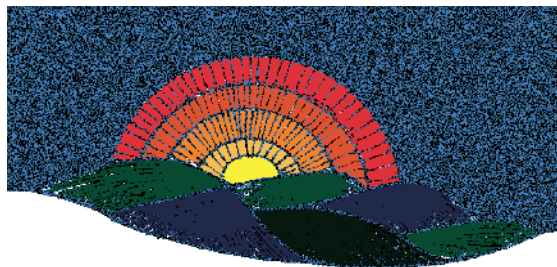
