Sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time

February 16, 2020

Sir 15:15-20; 1 Cor 2:6-10; Mt 5:17-37

Psalm 119

Dear families:

At the base of the gospel we read today is an inevitable dimension to being a Christian: the subjection to a deep and demanding moral law.

Certainly, Christianity is not just a set of truths to be believed, or just a simple catalog of precepts to fulfill. Besides that, and above that, it is a life to live.

Christianity is all three things, intimately linked. It is truth told by Jesus about His coming to the world, so that His sheep might have life and have it more abundantly... (John 10:10). But He conditioned this life to faith: "...whoever believes in the Son has eternal life..." (Jn 3:36); and as to the fulfillment of the commandments: "...not everyone who says to me, Lord, Lord, will enter the kingdom of heaven, but only the one who does the will of my Father in heaven..." (Mt 7:21). Remember the answer given to the young man who wanted to obtain eternal life: "Keep the commandments" (Mt 19:19).

In today's Gospel, Jesus is shown as a legislator, superior to Moses. Only He dared to correct Moses (and this, before a Jewish audience). Six times on this occasion He says, referring to the Law of Moses: "You have heard it said... but I say to you...". The characteristics of the new law enacted by Christ are simplification, interiority and higher moral standard. Faced with the multiplicity of precepts, which, according to the rabbis, were 248 positive and 365 negative, Jesus reduced them all to two: love of God and neighbor (Matt. 22:34-40). Then, as if even two seemed too many, He reduced them to one, at the Last Supper: "Love one another as I have loved you" (Jn 13:14; 15:12).

Interiority: The words are not what are important in the commandments, but rather the spirit. Goodness or malice is not in external works, but in the will or interior intention of the heart.

The signal demand of Christian morality is found in verse 20 (Matthew 5:20): "I tell you, unless your righteousness surpasses that of the scribes and Pharisees, in doing what God has commanded, you will not enter into the kingdom of heaven".

Today's gospel presents three cases related to the fifth, sixth and second commandments of the Law, in which Jesus demonstrates his preference for interiority and a greater moral imperative.

May the Peace of God be in your hearts.

Sexto Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

16 de febrero del 2020

Sir 15:16-21; 1 Cor 2:6-10; Mt 5:17-37

Salmo 119 [118]

Queridas familias:

A la base del evangelio que hoy leemos está una dimensión insoslayable del ser cristiano: el sometimiento a una ley moral profunda y exigente.

Cierto que el cristianismo no es solo un conjunto de verdades que hay que creer, ni solo un simple catálogo de preceptos que cumplir. Además de eso y por encima de eso, es una vida que vivir.

El cristianismo es las tres cosas íntimamente relacionadas entre sí. Es verdad que Jesús hijo haber venido al mundo para que sus ovejas tengan vida y la tengan en abundancia (Juan 10:10). Pero condicionó esta vida a la fe: el que cree en el Hijo del hombre tiene vida eterna (Jn 3:36); y al cumplimiento de los mandamientos: todo el que me diga: Señor, Señor, entrar en el reino de los cielos, sino el que cumpla la voluntad del mi Padre que está en los cielos (Mt 7:21). Recuerden la respuesta al joven que quer' a conseguir la vida eterna: Guarda los mandamientos (Mt. 19:19).

En el evangelio de hoy Jesús se muestra legislador superior a Moisés. Solo él (y ante un auditorio judío) pudo atreverse a corregir a Moisés. Por seis veces en esta ocasión dice refiriéndose a la Ley de Moisés: Ustedes han oído que se dijo pero yo les digo. Las características de la nueva ley promulgada por Cristo son: simplificación, interioridad y una mayor exigencia moral. Frente a la multiplicidad de preceptos, que, según los rabinos, eran 248 positivos y 365 negativos, Jesús redujo todos a dos: el amor a Dios y al prójimo (Mt. 22:34-40). Y como si le parecieran demasiados, en la Última Cena los redujo a uno: Que se amen unos a otros como yo les he amado (Jn 13:14; 15:12).

La interioridad: Lo importante en los mandamientos no es la letra, sino el espíritu. La bondad o la malicia no está en la obra externa, sino en la voluntad o intención interior del corazón.

Y la mayor exigencia de la moral cristiana aparece en el versículo 20 (Mt 5:20): Porque les digo a ustedes que, si no superan a los maestros de la ley y a los fariseos en hacer lo que Dios ha ordenado, nunca entrarán en el Reino de Dios.

Por último, el evangelio de hoy presenta tres casos relacionados con el quinto, sexto y el segundo mandamiento de la Ley, en los que Jesús muestra su opción por la interioridad y por una mayor exigencia moral.

Que la Paz de Dios esté en sus corazones.



Monsignor Gerry died February 3, 2020 surrounded by his family and friends. Born in Cavan, Ireland, Finegan was ordained there on June 18, 1967, at St. Patrick's Cathedral. Shortly after being ordained, he was sent to the United States to serve in the St. Augustine Diocese. Having served in the Diocese of Venice since its inception in 1984, Monsignor was Pastor of St. Mary Star of the Sea Parish from 2008 until his retirement in November of 2019. Prior to that Monsignor Gerry was Pastor of Incarnation Parish in Sarasota from 1976 to 2008. May his soul and the soul of all the faithful departed through the mercy of God rest in eternal peace.
