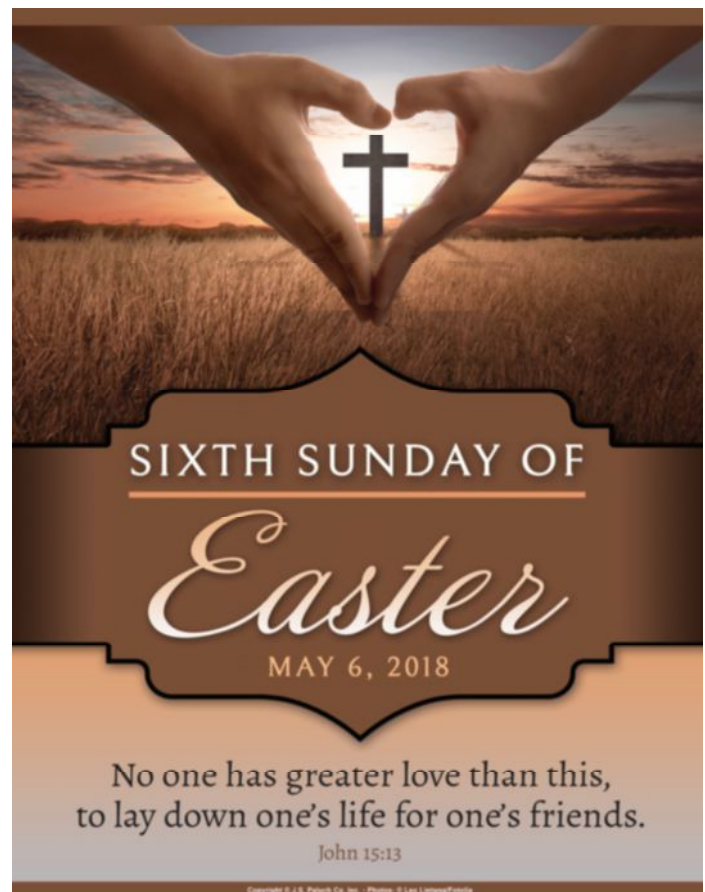

Psalm 98

Dear Families:

In today's Gospel, Jesus tells us that there is no greater love than to lay down one's life for one's friends. It is of little use, therefore, to say we believe in Jesus unless we show our love every day. Faith that is not driven by love is not faith, and the love that we give to others, especially to the most weak, is the strongest sign of our friendship with Jesus.

Today's Gospel is the center of Christian life. It speaks of the commandment - the one commandment: "That you love one another as I have loved you". But, can love be a commandment - an order? Can we be ordered to love? Actually, love is thought of as something that comes from inside a person, not from an order originating outside that person. In the military, orders are issued and obeyed. At work, it is often nearly the same. But no one can order us to feel for those around us. That's something different.

Jesus knows that this is something different. Jesus has experienced the love of God. Moreover, He has experienced that God is love. His presence in our world is a concrete, real sign of God's love for each one of us; the love that gives us life. God's love created this world and keeps it in existence, despite how badly we treat it, and how badly we treat each other. This is the reason why Jesus speaks of the commandment of love. **Because God has loved us first;** because we are creatures of His love. Love, as told in the second reading, is not something that comes from us, but rather, is born of **God. He is the origin of love,** of that life stream without which we cannot live.

There is no way to place boundaries on the love that comes from God. For God there are no Jews or pagans. That's the surprise of the Jews in this reading of Acts. God is beyond all rules and traditions. His love is stronger than any human law. God gives Himself to all of us.

Today's readings speak of the commandment of love. But, in reality, they invite us to look at the love with which God loves and cares for us. Only through this experience will our own love sprout; our ability to love and give life to those who will be born, and to love those around us. It's like trying to convince someone that not going to Mass on Sunday is a sin. It's much better to invite them to join our community, let them enjoy the celebration of Mass through the music, with brotherhood, with their encounter with Jesus. It is more likely that they would return than if we threaten with punishment and sin. When it comes to love, something similar happens. Nobody is going to love under the threat of a fine, but it is easier to love when love is felt and recognized by those around us.

Today, it is in our power to make known to those who live with us the love with which God loves them. It means nothing else in the practice of being Christians.

Sexto Domingo de Pascua

6 de Mayo del 2018

Hch 10:25-26, 34-35, 44-48; 1 Jn 4:7-10; Jn 15:9-17
Salmo 98 [97]

Queridas familias:

Jesús nos dice en el evangelio que leemos hoy que no hay amor más grande que el de dar la vida por los amigos. De poco nos sirve, por tanto, decir que creemos en Jesús si no lo demostramos con nuestro amor día a día. La fe que no es activa en el amor no es fe. Y el amor a las personas, y especialmente a los más débiles, es la señal más fuerte de nuestra amistad con Jesús.

El evangelio de hoy va al centro de la vida cristiana. Nos habla del mandamiento, del único mandamiento: **Que se amen unos a otros como yo los he amado.** Pero, ¿puede ser el amar un mandamiento, una orden? ¿Nos pueden ordenar que amemos? En realidad, el amor se piensa como algo que brota de adentro de una persona, no de una orden recibida de otro. En el ejército se dan y se obedecen órdenes. En el trabajo sucede lo mismo. Pero nadie nos puede ordenar que tengamos que sentir hacia quienes nos rodean. Eso es algo diferente.

Jesús sabe que es algo diferente. Jesús ha experimentado el amor de Dios. Es más, ha experimentado que Dios es amor. Su presencia en nuestro mundo es un signo concreto, real, de ese amor de Dios por cada uno de nosotros. Ese amor es el que nos da la vida. El amor de Dios es el que creó este mundo y el que lo mantiene en su existencia, a pesar de lo mal que lo tratamos y que nos tratamos unos a otros. Ah' está la razón por la que Jesús habla del mandamiento del amor. **Porque Dios nos ha amado primero.** Porque somos criaturas de su amor. El amor, como dice la segunda lectura, no es algo que nace de nosotros sino que nace de **Dios. El es el origen del amor,** de esa corriente vital sin la que no podemos vivir.

No hay forma de ponerle fronteras al amor que viene de Dios. Para Dios no hay judíos ni paganos. Esa es la sorpresa de los judíos en esta lectura de Hechos. Dios va más allá de todas las normas y tradiciones. Su amor es más fuerte que cualquier ley humana. Dios se regala y se da a todos.

Las lecturas de hoy nos hablan del mandamiento del amor. Pero en realidad nos invitan a fijarnos en el amor con el que Dios nos ama y nos cuida. Sólo de esta experiencia brotará nuestro propio amor, nuestra capacidad de amar y regalar la vida a los que van a nacer y a los que nos rodean. Es algo parecido a intentar convencer a alguien de que no ir a Misa los domingos es pecado. Es mucho mejor invitarlo a venir a nuestra comunidad, hacerle que disfrute en la celebración de la Misa con los cantos, con la fraternidad, con el encuentro con Jesús. Es muy fácil que vuelva. Pero si lo amenazamos con el pecado y el castigo, es muy fácil que no vuelva. Con el amor sucede algo parecido. Nadie va a amar bajo la amenaza de una multa si no lo hace. Pero es muy fácil que ame si se ha sentido amado y reconocido por los que le rodean.

Hoy están en nuestras manos hacer conocer a los que viven con nosotros el amor con el que Dios los ama. No otra cosa significa en la práctica ser cristianos.

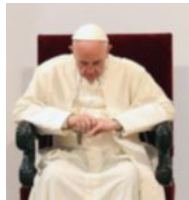
